

1. **Two week capsule course in Endangered Species and Zoo Management for Zoo Directors** was organized at Indira Gandhi Zoological Park, Vishakapatnam from 7th to 16th February, 2001 in collaboration with the WII at a cost of Rs. 6.12 lakhs. it was attended by 15 participants.
2. **Training programme for Zoo Keepers** at :-
 - (i) Nandankanan Zoological Park, Bhubaneshwar (from 11th to 17th February & 4th to 10th March, 2001)
 - (ii) Kanpur Zoological Park, Kanpur (from 1.2.2001 to 11.2.2001)
 - (iii) Nehru Zoological Park, Hyderabad (from 10.2.2001 to 19.2.2001)
 - (iv)(iii) Assam State Zoo, Guwahati (from 16.3.2002 to 22.3.2002)
 - (v) In all 109 animal keepers were trained. CZA has provided Rs. 4.00 lakhs for conducting these programmes.
3. Shri Y. S. Yalaki, Director, Thiruvanthapuram Zoo, Kerala and Dr. S. K. Bhowmick, Veterinary Officer, Sepahijal Zoological Park Tripura participated in **a three weeks course on " Conservation of Endangered Species" at Durrell Wildlife Conservation Trust, Jersey, UK** during July-August, 2000. The CZA provided Rs. 3.49 lakhs to meet the fees, travel and stay costs of the two officers.
4. **A Workshop on Zoo Design** was organized in collaboration with School of Planning and Architecture (SPA) in New Delhi between 27th November to 2nd December 2000. Architects, landscape designers and engineers from the zoos and all over the country participated in the Workshop. The CZA provided Rs. 4.55 lakhs to SPA for organizing the workshop.
5. **Zoo Directors Conference** was organized at Vishakapatnam on 16-17 February 2001. The main objective of the conference was to prepare an animal collection plan for each zoo as laid out in the National Zoo Policy.
6. The Central Zoo Authority sponsored a workshop for "Zoo Directors" focusing on the theme "Zoos in the next Millenium" was held at Kolkata during 28th - 30th April, 2001 on the occasion of 125th Anniversary of the Alipore Zoological Garden, Kolkata.
7. CZA sponsored workshop on "Expert Consultation on blood borne diseases diagnosis, cure and Prevention" was held at Chennai during 19th – 20th July, 2000. In total 48 participants participated in this workshop.
