Shri Bharat J Pathak joined the Indian Forest Services in May, 1984 after passing the UPSC examination. Before joining IFS services, he joined Training and Services as ACF in November 1979 after passing GPSC selection examination. He also got Diploma in Forestry and allied subjects, from Indian Forest College, IGNFA, Dehradun during the year 1984-1986 and obtained first rank.

During his service he was actively involved in the fields of Forest Management working plans, Forest Management & Conservation, Planning and Management of Botanical Garden, Zoological Park Development & Management, Ecological Research & Education and Implementation and planning of the Integrated Conservation and Development Projects (World Bank and Govt. of India sponsored (A) India Eco-development Project and Biodiversity Conservation and (b) Rural Livelihood Improvement Project).

He is a member of the National Wildlife Board, State Wildlife Board and Technical Advisory Committee of the National Biodiversity Authority. After being retired from the IFS services on 26th Feb, 2016, he served as a Director, VIKSAT, Voluntary Organization for Sustainable Development (April 2016 to March, 2017) and also served as a Director, State Institute of Rural Development, Gujarat (March 2017- 14.05.2018).
