**Sub:- Designs for the construction of various enclosures at Pt. G. B. Pant High Altitude Zoo, Nainital.**

Sir,

The designs for the construction of various enclosures at Pt. G. B. Pant High Altitude Zoo, Nainital were placed before the members of the Expert Group on Zoo Designing of the Central Zoo Authority in its Meeting held on 25<sup>th</sup> March, 2014. The proposal was scrutinized and following observations were made:-

1. Revised design of Pheasantry

The revised design was scrutinized and approved.

2. Revised design of the Canids exhibit

The design was scrutinized and not approved, however, following observations were made:

- The number of canids species at the zoo should be confined to two only & accordingly paddock should be divided in to two equal parts.
- The number of feeding cells available in one paddock should be five & four, subject to the compatibility of group. The zoo may limit the number of animals in such a way that they can be accommodated in the feedings cells.
- Each feeding cell will have hinge door towards the keepers gallery & drop slide towards the paddock.
- There should be sliding door as a partition in feeding cell.

You are requested to submit the revised design incorporating the above suggestions for scrutiny and approval.

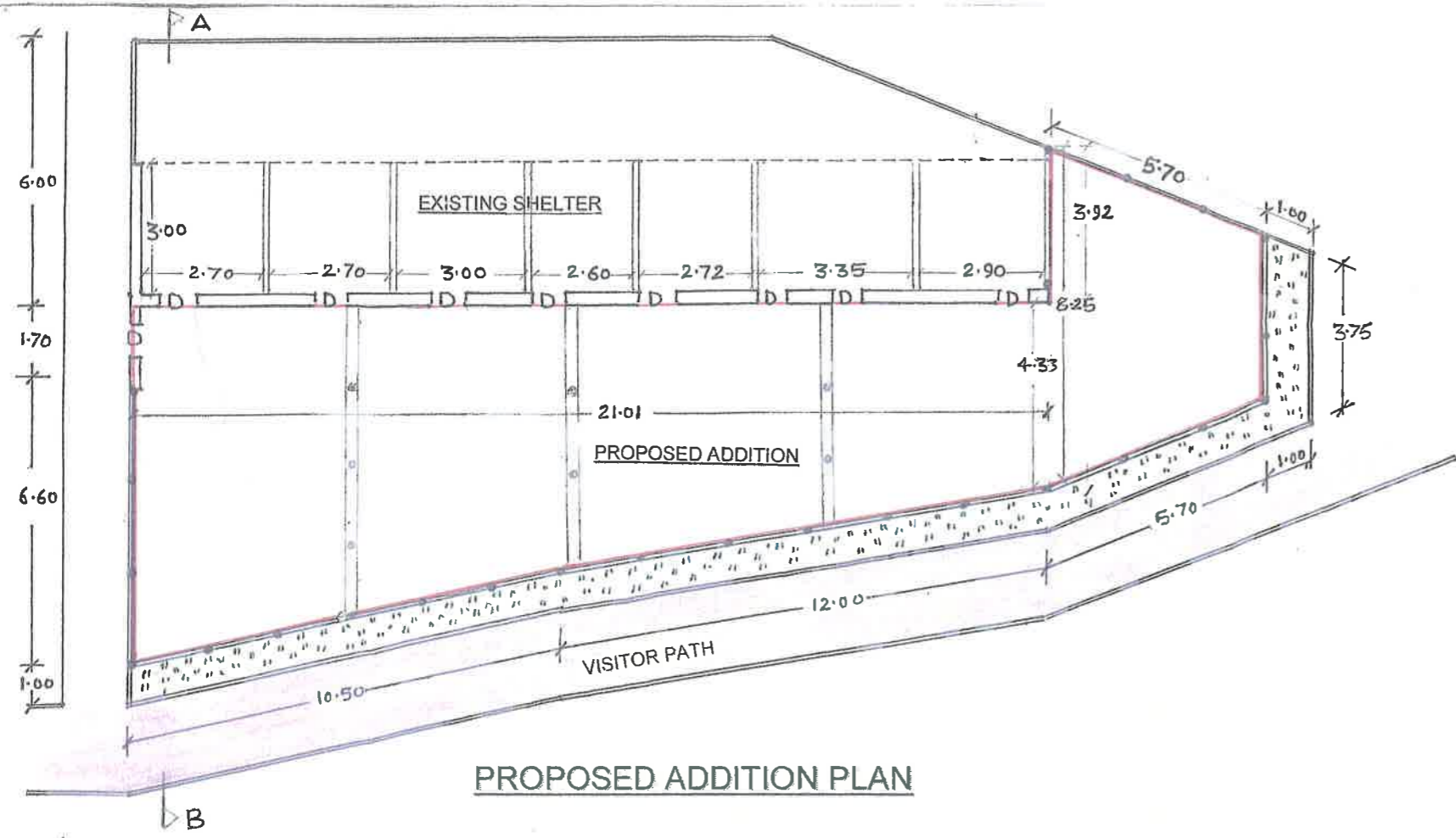

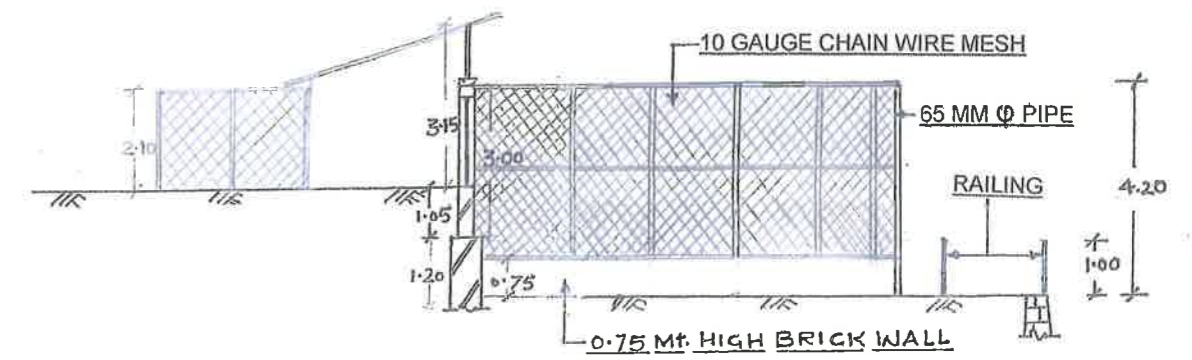

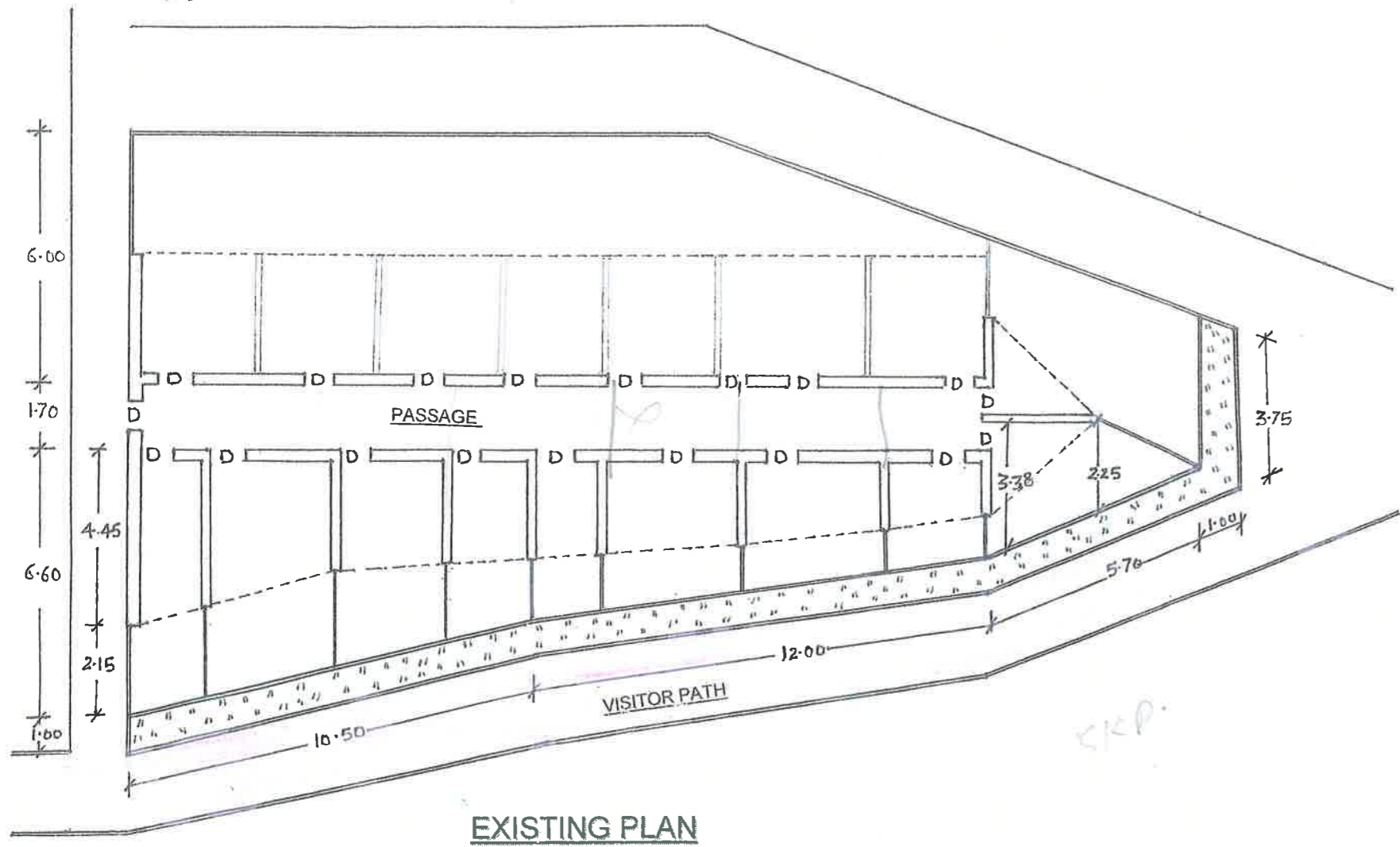
