

Guidelines for setting up of Deer Parks*

- 1. Area of the Deer Park should be atleast five (5) hectares.
- 2. The deer park should be at a reasonable distance from the residential accommodations and roads, so that the animals are not provoked unnecessary.
- 3. The Zoo/deer park should have a small treatment room.
- 4. The zoo should have a post-mortem room.
- 5. Arrangement should be made with a Veterinarian to check the health of animals daily.
- 6. Arrangement for round the clock supply of potable water should be made in the animal enclosures.
- 7. The number of animals in the deer parks should not be more than one animal for larger ungulates and three animals per acre for smaller ungulates.
- 8. To safe-guard against inbreeding, periodic exchange of animals specially males, should be made with other zoos/deer parks.
- 9. Fodder trees and shade trees should be planted in the deer park area.
- 10. Night shelter/kraals should be constructed for the deers.
