- On June 5th World Environment Day was celebrated. A district wide election competition for Higher Secondary School students was conducted and cash prizes were given to winners. A

- A vegetable Garden has been started foreseeing production of fertilizer free vegetables for the feeding of animals and birds in the mini zoo.
- Photography competition was held for College students based on the theme 'Animals Rights' on December 10th , Human Rights day 2016. Winners were given cash awards and mementos.
- All enclosures were added with Foot bath for keepers and signages were renewed, adding relevant information.
- All staff were provided with new uniforms and safety shoes.
- Sensitization campaign for visitors, highlighting the importance of conservation of nature and snakes in particular are held on daily basis.
