**ORDER**

Whereas, Dr. B.M.Arora submitted three RTI applications dated 29.8.2016. The subject matter of the RTI contained information in respect of endangered species bred in CZA recognized Indian zoos with support of CZA financial grants; books, manuals, periodicals and handouts published with CZA financial grants; and details of research projects carried out with CZA financial grants.

Whereas, the PIO, Central Zoo Authority informed the applicant vide letter No.13-4/2006-CZA(Vol.VIII)(PT)/2724/2016 dated 28.9.2016 stating therein that the concerned information is voluminous and needed compilation and therefore was requested to visit CZA to collect the desired information.

Whereas, applicant was not satisfied with the reply furnished by the PIO, CZA, and submitted an appeal dated 4.10.2016 requesting for providing the detailed information with specific references.

Whereas, the RTI applications of Dr.B.M.Arora and the reply submitted by the PIO, CZA have been perused.

Now, therefore, no further action is required in the matter by the PIO, CZA.

And, the RTI applicant is further informed that he may approach the second Appellate Authority, the Central Information Commission, under the provisions of the RTI Act, 2005 in case he is not satisfied with the reply provided by the PIO, CZA.
