### ORDER

**Subject:- Cancellation of recognition of Hanuman Vatika Rescue Centre, Sultanpur, Gurugram, Haryana under Section 38H(6) of the Wildlife (Protection) Act, 1972- regarding**

Whereas, the recognition granted to the Hanuman Vatika Rescue Centre, Sultanpur, Gurugram, Haryana vide letter F No.22-74/2004-CZA(459)(M)/764 dtd.12 10 2011 was valid up to 31 10 2013

Whereas, the operator of Hanuman Vatika Rescue Centre failed to submit compliance of conditions stipulated by the Central Zoo Authority during last renewal of recognition and based on evaluation dated 05 04.2014

Whereas, an opportunity has been provided to the operator of the Hanuman Vatika Rescue Centre Gurugram, Haryana under Section 38H(6) of the Wildlife (Protection) Act, 1972 vide notice F No.22-74/2004-CZA(459)(AK)/2709/2016 dtd.26 09 2016, to submit any points, objections or facts for consideration of this authority to cancel its recognition

Whereas, the operator of the Hanuman Vatika Rescue Centre, Sultanpur, Gurugram, Haryana vide letter No Nil dtd. 27 09 2016 filed a reply to the Show Cause Notice, informing that all captive animals have been removed from the Hanuman Vatika Rescue Centre, rehabilitated and that no wild animals will be housed at the facility

Whereas, the reply filed has been placed before the Technical Committee of the CZA in its 80<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 4<sup>th</sup> November, 2016. After due deliberation, the Committee decided to cancel recognition of Hanuman Vatika Rescue Centre, Gurugram, Haryana.

Therefore, having given sufficient opportunity, the recognition of Hanuman Vatika Rescue Centre, Gurugram is hereby **cancelled**, under Section 38H(6) of the Wildlife (Protection) Act, 1972. However, the operator of the Hanuman Vatika Rescue Centre, Gurugram may prefer an appeal before the Central Government, under Section 38H(7) of the Wildlife (Protection) Act, 1972 within a period of 30 days from the issue of this order

We would like to submit that the monkeys brought to the Hanuman Vatika for treatment of injuries or for care have all recovered in due course and have been rehabilitated following due procedure and at the present time there are no animals being kept at the Center.

Since we are looking to make Hanuman Vatika a shelter for companion animals such as dogs, cats, etc, and are reconstructing the place to suit the needs of such species, we do not require the recognition from CZA any longer.
