With reference to your application cited above, replies to your queries are as follows:

S. No.	Query	Reply
1.	Whether IFS officers holding the rank/post of Conservator of Forests (CF) with grade pay of Rs.8,900 (Matrix Level 13A) were eligible for the aforesaid post. If yes, please mention the specific eligibility criterion under which they were eligible – a(i) or a(ii) or a (iii).	During scrutiny of applications both the applicants were found eligible as per recruitment rules of the post & past precedent followed in this authority.
2.	Whether IFS officers holding the rank/post of Chief Conservator of Forests (CCF) with grade pay of Rs.10,000 (Matrix Level 14) were eligible for the aforesaid post. If yes, please mention the specific eligibility criterion under which they were eligible – a(i) or a(ii) or a(iii).	
3.	I have received the information under the RTI Act that 2 Officers had applied for the aforesaid post-Shri S K Daila (IFS 2000 Batch) and Shri Shrawan Kumar Verma (IFS 1999 Batch) Which of these officers possesses more merit than the other in terms of the following criteria. (a) Experience in Wildlife Management (b) Marks in PAR/ACR of the last 5 years (c) Significant achievements in the field of Wildlife Management as recorded in PAR/ACR or otherwise. (d) International training and exposure in Wildlife Management	The recruitment rule of the post provides eligible criteria under clause A & B of column No. 11 of the schedule to the recruitment rules. Both applicants were found eligible as per recruitment rules and the past precedent. The criteria mentioned by you has not been mentioned in the recruitment rule for consideration of eligibility of the candidates.



The committee recommended the following candidates:- 1.Sh. Shrawan Kumar Verma, IFS (KL:1999) 2.Sh. Sushil Kumar Daila, IFS (AM : 2000)
