
Kindly refer to your RTI application dated 21.02.2018 received at this office on 23.02.2018 on the subject cited above.

**NOTIFICATION**

New Delhi, the 18th September, 2012

**G.S.R. 702(E).**—In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (c) of sub-section (1) of section 63 read with sub-section (7) of section 38(B) of the Wildlife (Protection) Act, 1972 (53 of 1972) and in supersession of the Central Zoo Authority (Officers and Other Employees) Recruitment Rules, 1994, in so far as they relate to the posts of Evaluation and Monitoring Officer, Finance Officer, Private Secretary, Accountant, Data Processing Assistant Grade 'A', Personal Assistant, Upper Division Clerk, Lower Division Clerk, Staff Car Driver and Peon, except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the Central Government hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment of the officers and other employees of the Central Zoo Authority, namely :—

**1. Short title and commencement.**— (1) These rules may be called the Central Zoo Authority (Officers and Other Employees) Recruitments Rules, 2012.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

**2. Application.**— These rules shall apply to the posts specified in column 1 of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

**3. Number of posts, classification, pay band and grade pay or pay scale.**—The number of said posts, their classification, pay band and grade pay or pay scale attached thereto shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4 of the said Schedule.

**4. Method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications, etc.**—The method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto shall be as specified in columns 5 to 13 of the aforesaid Schedule.

**5. Disqualification.**— No person,—

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or

(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

**6. Power to relax.**—Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

**7. Saving.**—Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age-limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Caste, the Scheduled Tribes, ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

Note 1. The period of deputation including the period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organisation or Department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not exceed five years.

Note 2 : The maximum age limit for appointment on deputation shall be not exceeding fifty six years as on the closing date of receipt of applications.

Note 3 : For the purpose of appointment on deputation basis, the service rendered on a regular basis by an officer prior to 1st January 2006 or the date from which revised pay structure based on the recommendations of the Sixth Central Pay Commission has been extended, shall be deemed to be service rendered in the corresponding grade pay or pay scale extended based on the recommendations of the said Pay Commission except where there has been merger of more than one pre-revised scale of pay into one grade with a common grade pay or pay scale, and where this benefit will extend only for the post (s) for which that grade pay or pay scale is the normal replacement grade without any upgradation.
