

(2)	Number of tiger deaths of tiger India between 14 June 2013 to 31 March 2018 (both in captivity and in wild) and number of tiger death cases where investigations have been conducted by RT-PCR process	The Number of tiger deaths in captivity (recognized zoos in India) is as under - 2013 - 14 - 49 2014 - 15 - 48 2015 - 16 - 48 2016 - 17 - 40 2017 - 18 - 17 (under compilation) The death case of tiger in wild does not come under the purview of the CZA. Further, the information regarding investigations of death cases may be obtained directly from the concerned Zoo Operator.
