The evaluation of the Jawahar Lake Tourist Complex, Shamirpet, Rangareddy District, Telangana was carried out by Dr. B. Trinadha Rao on 26.08.2014. The evaluation report of the Jawahar Lake Tourist Complex, Shamirpet, Rangareddy District, Telangana as submitted by the evaluating officers was considered by the Technical Committee in its 77th Meeting held on 20th January, 2016.

The Central Zoo Authority has decided to grant renewal of recognition to Jawahar Lake Tourist Complex, Shamirpet, Rangareddy District, Telangana as 'Mini Zoo' category under Section 38H of the Wild Life (Protection) Act, 1972 for a period up to 20.01.2018 subject to the compliance with the following directives under Rule 10 of Recognition of Zoo Rules, 2009 (Amended in 2013) and mid-term evaluation of the zoo:-
