**Sub:- Renewal of recognition to the Lady Hydari Park, Shillong, Meghalaya for period beyond 31.07.2014 under Section 38H(1) of the Wildlife (Protection) Act, 1972 – reg.**

1. The application No. 289 dated 23.07.2014 received from the Divisional Forest Officer, Khasi Hills Wildlife Division, Shillong, Meghalaya.

Sir,

Reference is invited to above cited correspondence. It is to inform that the evaluation of the Lady Hydari Park, Shillong, Meghalaya was carried out by Dr. Brij Kishor Gupta, Evaluation and Monitoring Officer, CZA on 13<sup>th</sup> June, 2017. The evaluation report of the Lady Hydari Park, Shillong as submitted by the evaluating officer was considered by the Technical Committee in its 84<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on 19.09.2017. After detailed deliberations, the Technical Committee has recommended to the Central Zoo Authority for renewal of recognition of the Lady Hydari Park, Shillong (Mini Zoo Category) for a period of one year.

The Central Zoo Authority in its 30<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on 28.09.2017, approved the recommendation of the Technical Committee and has decided to renew recognition to the Lady Hydari Park, Shillong for a period of one year. Further, the Authority has also decided to regularise the period after 31.07.2014.

The renewal of recognition to the Lady Hydari Park, Shillong as "a Mini Category Zoo" as per the provisions of Section 38H(1) of the Wild Life (Protection) Act, 1972 is for a period up to 27<sup>th</sup> September, 2018 subject to the compliance of the following directives under the Recognition of Zoo Rules, 2009 and mid-term evaluation of the zoo:-

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4.	3(8)	The zoo has been receiving the rescued animals like Rhesus macaques and Jackal and the same are being housed in exhibit, while the zoo already has exhibit for such species. Prior approval for all such animals should have been obtained from the CWLW of the State and the CZA.	With immediate effect
<b>4. Animal housing, display and animal enclosures</b>			
5.	4(1,2,3)	The animal enclosures provided to the Slow loris, Fox, Jackal and Palm civet are small in size. The zoo has not followed the dimension as prescribed by the CZA for animal exhibits and feeding & retiring cells.	Six months

14.	9(4)	The zoo has been housing single sexed animals of Palm civet, Fox, Jackal. Clouded leopard, Serow and Yellow throated marten. The zoo should make appropriate efforts to pair them, otherwise shift the animals to the recognized zoos who has the population of such animals. This should be done with prior approval from the CZA and the CWLW of the State.	Six months
<b>12. Visitors' facilities</b>			
15.	12(2)	The zoo has not been keeping the Snake anti-venom. It should be addressed.	With immediate effect.

A half yearly report regarding progress made in implementation of the aforesaid conditions should be submitted to the Central Zoo Authority.

The renewal of recognition to the Lady Hydari Park, Shillong for period beyond 27<sup>th</sup> September, 2018 as "a Mini Category Zoo" would be considered on the basis of compliance of the conditions stated above and general performance of the zoo.

The recognition to the Lady Hydari Park, Shillong shall be revoked by the Central Zoo Authority, at any point of time if the Zoo Operator is found not complying with the stipulated conditions.

Reference is invited to your letter No. FWC/G/87-Pt dated 22<sup>ND</sup> August, 2007 seeking grant of renewal of recognition to Lady Hydari Park and Animal Land, Shillong under Section 38H of the Wild Life (Protection) Act, 1972 beyond the period of 31.1.2007.

The evaluation of the zoo was carried out by Dr. B. R. Sharma on 2<sup>nd</sup> December, 2007. The evaluation report of the Lady Hydari Park and Animal Land, Shillong as submitted by the evaluating officer was considered by the Technical Committee in its 47<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on 18.2.2008.

The Central Zoo Authority has decided to grant recognition to Lady Hydari Park and Animal Land, Shillong as a small category Zoo under Section 38H of the Wild Life (Protection) Act, for a period up to 30.04.2010 subject to that comply with the directives issued vide this office letter No. 19-169/93-CZA(Vol.II)(189) dated 5.12.2007 and ensure that standards and norms as laid under Recognition of Zoo Rules, 1992 are followed.

Your decision with regard to issue of relocation of the existing Zoo to a new site near Umtrew Village in Ri-Bhoi District or improving the same at the existing site. Your reply should reach to the Central Zoo Authority positively before 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2009. It is to bring into your kind notice that in both the cases you should prepare a long-term Master plan for its development in the format circulated by the Central Zoo Authority during the year 2005 and the same is published in the CZA's publication "Zoos in India-Legislation, Policy, Guidelines and Strategy". The copies of the said plan should be submitted to the Central Zoo Authority for its approval within the same period i.e by 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2009.

A report regarding progress made in implementation of the aforesaid conditions should be submitted to the Central Zoo Authority within 31<sup>st</sup> July, 2008.

Grant of recognition beyond 31.04.2010 to Lady Hydari Park and Animal Land, Shillong as a small category zoo would be considered on the basis of compliance of the conditions stated above, general performance and physical evaluation of the zoo.

The recognition to the Lady Hydari Park and Animal Land, Shillong shall be revoked by the Central Zoo Authority, at any point of time if the zoo operator is found not complying with the stipulated conditions.

Grant of recognition beyond 31.01.2007 would be considered on the basis of compliance of the conditions stated above and status of relocation of the existing zoo to the new site.

You are requested to submit the master plan (along with layout plan) of the new site of the zoo in Umtrew village in Ri-Bhoi District of Meghalaya before May, 2005 for the approval of the Central Zoo Authority.
