Reference is invited to above cited correspondence. It is to inform that the evaluation of Deer Park at Papadahandi, Nabarangpur, Odisha was carried out by Dr. Devender Kumar on 27th June, 2016. The evaluation report of the Deer Park at Papadahandi, Nabarangpur, as submitted by the evaluating officer was considered by the Technical Committee in its 79th Meeting held on 24th August, 2016.

The Technical Committee of the Central Zoo Authority has decided to grant conditional renewal of recognition for a period of two years. The renewal of recognition of Deer Park at Papadahandi, Nabarangpur, as a "Mini Category Zoo" as per the provisions of Section 38H of the Wild Life (Protection) Act, 1972 is for a period up to 23rd August, 2018 subject to the compliance of the following directives under the Recognition of Zoo Rules, 2009 and mid-term evaluation of the zoo:-

The evaluation of the Deer Park, Papdahandi was carried out by Sh. Sri G. Ramalingam, Curator, Indira Gandhi Zoological Park, Visakhapatnam on 29.04.2011. The evaluation report of the Deer Park, Papdahandi as submitted by the evaluating officers was considered by the Technical Committee in its 59th Meeting held on 20th September, 2011.

The Central Zoo Authority has decided to grant of recognition to Deer Park, Papdahandi as a Mini Category Zoo under Section 38H of the Wild Life (Protection) Act, for a period up to 31st October, 2014 subject to the compliance of the following directives under the Recognition of Zoo Rules, 2009 and mid-term evaluation of the zoo:-
