Reference is invited to your letter No. Hort./2013-14/839 dated 08/10.04.2013 seeking renewal of recognition to the Indira Gandhi Park-Zoo and Deer Park, Rourkela beyond the period of 31.05.2013 under Section 38H of the Wild Life (Protection) Act, 1972 .

The evaluation of the Indira Gandhi Park-Zoo and Deer Park, Rourkela was carried out on 11.08.2013 by Sh. C. R. Bhattacharya. The evaluation report submitted by the evaluating officer was approved the Chairman, Technical committee of the Central Zoo Authority vide note dated 30.12.2013 subject to post-facto approval & ratification in next Technical Committee of the CZA.

The Central Zoo Authority has decided to grant of renewal of recognition to the Indira Gandhi Park-Zoo and Deer Park, Rourkela as "Small Category Zoo" under Section 38H of the Wild Life (Protection) Act, for a period up to 31st January, 2017 subject to the compliance of the following directives under the Recognition of Zoo (Amendment) Rules, 2013 and mid-term evaluation of the Zoo:-



Reference is invited to your letter No. Hort.-2 (173)/2003-04/415 dated 8.7.2003 seeking renewal of recognition for the Indira Gandhi Zoo and Deer Park, Rourkela beyond 31.7.2003 under Section 38H of the Wild Life (Protection) Act, 1972.

The evaluation report of the Indira Gandhi Zoo and Deer Park, Rourkela as submitted by the evaluating team comprising of Mr. A. K. Das and Dr. T. L. Som was considered by the Technical Committee in its meeting held on 7.7.2004.

On the recommendations of the Committee, it has been decided to grant renewal of recognition to the Indira Gandhi Zoo and Deer Park, Rourkela for a period up to 30.9.2005 subject to following conditions:-

1.	11A	The zoo should prepare a collection plan of animals to be housed and displayed in the zoo.
Administrative & Staffing Pattern		
2.	13	The zoo should post an official with Masters Degree in Wildlife Science/Zoology as full time Curator solely responsible for looking after the upkeep of animals and maintenance of animal enclosures.
3.	14/14A	The zoo should post a full time veterinarian having qualification of BV.Sc. and AH or equivalent with a minimum of 5 years experience of working in a zoo recognized by the CZA. The veterinarian should be duly registered with the State Veterinary Council/Veterinary Council of India.

... and ... and ... the zoo ... the number of ... and the housing structures are ...

The zoo authorities may seek help of the Health Advisory Committee constituted by the Government of Orissa for helping the zoos in the State with respect to veterinary matters as well as the Forest Department for preparing a strategic plan for gradually reducing the population of spotted deers in the zoo.

Education & Research	
1.	Every enclosure in the zoo should bear a sign board displaying scientific and ecological information regarding the animals exhibited in it.
Other recommendations	
1.	The empty rhesus macaque enclosure should be dismantled immediately to provide the visitors a better view of the sloth bear enclosure.
2.	Necessary action under Section 38B of the Wild Life (Protection) Act should be taken against such persons who are found engaged in activities like teasing of animals, injuring or feeding or any other activities that may cause disturbance to the animals by noise or otherwise or by littering the zoo grounds.

A half yearly report regarding progress made in implementation of the aforesaid conditions should be submitted to the Central Zoo Authority.

Grant of recognition beyond 30.9.2008 would be considered on the basis of compliance of the conditions stated above and general performance of the zoo.
