Sir,

Please refer to your letter No. KD/WSD/617/03/117 dated 6.2.2003 seeking renewal of recognition for the HAL Deer Park, Koraput, Sunabeda beyond 31.8.2000 under Section 38H of the Wild Life (Protection) Act, 1972.

The evaluation report as submitted by Dr. Anupam Srivastav was placed before the Technical Committee in its Meeting held on 21.7.2006.

On the basis of the recommendation of the committee, the Central Zoo Authority has decided to grant renewal of recognition to HAL Deer Park, Koraput, Sunabeda as a 'Mini category zoo' beyond 31.8.2000 under Section 38H (3) of the Wild Life (Protection) Act, for a period upto 31.12.2008 subject to fulfillment of the following conditions:-

- A.** The area of the Deer Park should be increased to 5 hectares.
- B.** **Conditions to be complied under Rule 10 of Recognition of Zoo Rules, 1992.**
