Reference is invited to above cited correspondence. It is to inform that the evaluation of the Pachwati Deer Park, Pilani was carried out by Dr. Devender Kumar, Scientific Officer, CZA on 19.02.2017. The evaluation report of the Pachwati Deer Park, Pilani, as submitted by the evaluating officer was considered by the Technical Committee in its 82nd Meeting held on 22nd March, 2017. Copy of evaluation report is enclosed with this letter for your perusal.

The Technical Committee of the Central Zoo Authority has decided to grant conditional renewal of recognition for a period of one year. The renewal of recognition of the Pachwati Deer Park, Pilani as a "Mini category zoo" under provisions of Section 38H of the Wild Life (Protection) Act, 1972 is for a period up to 21st March, 2018 subject to the compliance of the following directives under the Recognition of Zoo Rules, 2009 and mid-term evaluation of the Zoo:

Reference is invited to your letter No. PCT/2013/96 dated 28.05.2013 seeking renewal of recognition to Panchwati Deer Park, Pilani under Section 38H of the Wild Life (Protection) Act, 1972 beyond the period of 31.08.2013.

The evaluation of the Panchwati Deer Park, Pilani was carried out on 13.02.2014 by Dr. A. K. Malhotra. The evaluation report submitted by the evaluating officer was placed before the 69th Technical Committee Meeting held on 26th March, 2014. The committee decided that the renewal of recognition to the Panchwati Deer Park, Pilani should be suspended as per the Section 38 H (6) of the Wildlife (Protection) Act, 1972 and issue a show cause notice to Zoo Director for not complying the provisions/standards stipulated by CZA & also not providing veterinary health care facilities at the zoo in particular.

The Zoo In-charge has submitted a reply stating that the zoo has now constructed a treatment section as well as agreement has been signed with the Government Veterinary Hospital for the visit of Veterinary Officer, every week to the Panchwati Deer Park, Pilani for the health check up of the animals.

The Central Zoo Authority vide its letter dated 16.06.2014 had further requested the Zoo in-charge, Panchwati Deer Park to submit the copy of agreement with regard to the visit of Veterinary Officer from the Government Veterinary Hospital to the zoo. As the Zoo In-charge of the Panchwati Deer Park, Pilani has now submitted the copy of agreement signed between the Deer Park authorities and Veterinary Hospital and requested the Central Zoo Authority for grant of renewal of recognition. The same was placed before the 70th Technical Committee Meeting of the CZA held on 1st July, 2014.


