Reference is invited to above cited correspondence. It is to inform that the evaluation of the Sarnath Deer Park, Varanasi was carried out by Shri Himanshu Malhotra on 16th March, 2016. The evaluation report of the Sarnath Deer Park, Varanasi as submitted by the evaluating officer was considered by the Technical Committee in its 78th Meeting held on 6th May, 2016.

The Technical Committee of the Central Zoo Authority has decided to grant conditional renewal for recognition for a period of two years. The renewal of recognition of Sarnath Deer Park, Varanasi as "a Mini Category Zoo" as per the provisions of Section 38H of the Wild Life (Protection) Act, 1972 is for a period up to 5th May, 2018 subject to the compliance of the following directives under Rule 10 of Recognition of Zoo Rules, 2009 (Amended in 2013) and mid-term evaluation of the zoo:-

The evaluation report submitted by the evaluating officer was considered by the Technical Committee in its 52nd Meeting held on 20th January, 2010.

The Central Zoo Authority has decided to grant of renewal of recognition to the Sarnath Deer Park, Varanasi as a mini category Zoo under Section 38H of the Wild Life (Protection) Act, for a period up to 31st March, 2013 subject to the compliance of the following directives under the Recognition of Zoo Rules, 2009:-
