Sir,

The evaluation of the Mini Zoo, Roing, Arunachal Pradesh was carried out by Sh. R.C. Bhattacharjee on 17.04.2015. The evaluation report of Mini Zoo, Roing, Arunachal Pradesh as submitted by the evaluating officer was considered by the Technical Committee in its 75th Meeting of Central Zoo Authority held on 15th July 2015.

The Central Zoo Authority has decided to grant renewal of recognition to Mini Zoo, Roing, Arunachal Pradesh as "Mini Zoo" under Section 38H of the Wild Life (Protection) Act, for a period up to 31st January, 2016 subject to the compliance of the following conditions under the Recognition of Zoo (Amendment) Rules, 2013 and mid-term evaluation of the Zoo:-

1	3 (1)	Top priority is to be given to complete the Master Plan.	One year
5. Upkeep and health care			
2	5 (5)	Clear the premises of the zoo, from all debris in such a manner that it has no adverse impact on the hygiene and cleanliness of the zoo.	Immediately
6. Veterinary and Infrastructure facilities			
3	6(5)	The zoo should have linkages with the eminent organizations working in the field to provide training to its staff including zoo keepers.	Immediately

9. Acquisition and breeding of animals			
4	9 (3)	Zoo should make efforts to procure a pair of Asiatic black bear for pairing the single animal. A proposal may be submitted to CZA.	6 months
5	9(12)	Separate the Assamese macaque from the Rhesus macaques.	Immediately

A half yearly report regarding progress made in implementation of the aforesaid condition should be submitted to the Central Zoo Authority.

Grant of recognition Mini Zoo, Roing, Arunachal Pradesh beyond the period of 31st January, 2016 would be considered on the basis of compliance of the condition stated above and general performance of the Zoo at that point of time.

You are further requested to submit Master (layout) Plan at the earliest for approval of the Central Zoo Authority, so that proposals for funding construction of enclosures, whose designs are approved, may be considered by the Central Zoo Authority. Further, the help of the Wildlife Trust of India, Noida may be taken in preparation of Master Plan of the zoo.

The recognition to the Mini Zoo, Roing, Arunachal Pradesh shall be revoked by the Central Zoo Authority, at any point of time if the Zoo Operator is found not complying with the above stipulated conditions.

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

Reference is invited to above cited correspondence.

The Mini Zoo at Roing was evaluated by Shri D. N. Singh on 6th June, 2008. The evaluation report of the Mini Zoo, Roing as submitted by the evaluating officer was considered by the Technical Committee in its 48th Meeting held on 23rd July, 2008.

The Central Zoo Authority has decided to grant of recognition to the Mini Zoo at Roing as Mini Category Zoo under Section 38H of the Wild Life (Protection) Act, for a period up to 30.09.2010 subject to the compliance of the following directives under the Recognition of Zoo Rules, 1992:-

1.	1	The domestic animals like Rabbits and Guinea fowls should be removed from the zoo area.	With immediate effect

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2.	8	The Zoo should be encompassed by a perimeter wall/ chain link fence/ hot wire barrier to prevent the entry of feral dogs and other domestic animals in the premises of the Zoo.	Six months
3.	11A	(i) The Zoo should house only those animals which can not be released back to into the wild and that appropriate housing facility available at the Zoo. (ii) The individuals of those endangered species received as rescued and those can not be released back into the wild, the efforts should be made to transfer such animals to the recognized zoos in the State or neighbouring state in consultation with the Central Zoo Authority.	With immediate effect

4.	12	The Zoo should depute a Forest Range Officer or Forester level officer as full time In-charge for day to day management of the Zoo.	With immediate effect
Animal Enclosures – Design, Dimensions and other Essential Features			
5.	16	The Zoo Operator should create/ modify/ improve animal housing for those wild animals which can not be released back to the wild. The enclose copy of recommended concept plan of the Central Zoo Authority should be followed. The animal enclosures in the Zoo should be so designed as to meet the biological requirements of the animals housed therein. The enclosure should be of such size as to ensure that the animals get space for their free movement and exercise. The enclosures and feeding/ retiring cubicles shall not be smaller than the dimensions prescribed in <u>Appendix I & II</u> of the Recognition of Zoo Rules, 1992.	Six months
6.	16A	Appropriate screening between the adjacent enclosures should be provided to safeguard against the animals getting exited or stressed because of the visibility of animals in other enclosures.	Three months
7.	17	The Zoo Operator should provide every enclosure with planting appropriate species of trees for providing shade and shelter, dead wooden logs, branches as an environmental enrichment and the same should be finalized as per the species requirement.	Three months

8.	18	Barking deer should be provided with appropriate housing facility.	With immediate effect
9.	20	The designing of animal enclosures for any of the species to be housed at the Centre for its life time care, should have got prior approval of the Central Zoo Authority before its construction.	With immediate effect

Maintenance of Records and Submission of inventory to the Central Zoo Authority			
19.	42	The records of birth, acquisition, disposals and deaths of the animals should be maintained. The inventory of the animals in the zoo as on 31 st March of every year shall be submitted to the Central Zoo Authority by 30 th April of the same year.	With immediate effect
20.	43	A brief summary of the death of animals in the zoo for every financial year, along with the reasons of death identified on the basis of the postmortem report and diagnostic tests should be submitted to the Central Zoo Authority.	With immediate effect
21.	44	The Zoo Operator should submit an Annual Report for activities of the Centre in respect of each financial year to the Central Zoo Authority.	With immediate effect

22.	51	The Zoo should prepare a theme based long-term (for a minimum period of 20 years) master plan for its development including a management plan for next six years giving details of the proposals and activities of development during the period. The copies of the said plan shall be sent to the Central Zoo Authority before 31 st March, 2009 for its approval.
