Reference is invited to above cited correspondence. It is to inform that the evaluation of People for Animals Rescue Centre, Wardha was carried out by Dr. Brij Kishor Gupta, Evaluation and Monitoring Officer, Central Zoo Authority on 27th September, 2016. The evaluation report of the People for Animals Rescue Centre, Wardha as submitted by the evaluating officer was considered by the Technical Committee in its 80th Meeting held on 4th November, 2016.

The Technical Committee of the Central Zoo Authority has decided to grant conditional renewal of recognition for a period of two years. The renewal of recognition of People for Animals Rescue Centre, Wardha as a "Rescue Centre Category" as per the provisions of Section 38H of the Wild Life (Protection) Act, 1972 is for a period up to 3rd November, 2018, subject to the compliance of the following directives under the Recognition of Zoo Rules, 2009 and mid-term evaluation of the zoo:-

4	1(9)	The Domestic geese (15 nos.), Rabbits (20 nos.), and Guinea fowl (2 Nos.) should be removed immediately.	Immediately
5	1(9)	The gate opening towards the domestic animals shelter should be permanently closed, as the feral dogs were seen roaming in the Rescue Centre premises. The Rescue Centre should have independent entry and exit.	Immediately
4. Animal housing, display of animals and animal enclosures			
6	4(2)	The enclosure constructed to house the snakes should be redesigned following the norms as prescribed by the CZA. Prior approval of the design should be obtained from the CZA.	Four months
7	4(3)	The slope in the Nilgai enclosure seems to be steep, it should be made gentle by filling the adequate amount of soil.	Two months
8	4(6)	MS wires should not be used as enrichment, instead wooden twigs, bamboo and natural material should be used and the food should be provided at an elevated platform.	One month

9		The approved copy of Master (layout) Plan and Master Plan should be kept at the site itself.	Immediately

A half yearly report regarding progress made in implementation of the aforesaid conditions should be submitted to the Central Zoo Authority.

The renewal of recognition to People for Animals Rescue Centre, Wardha for period beyond 3rd November, 2018 as a "Rescue Centre Category" would be considered on the basis of compliance of the conditions stated above and general performance of the zoo.

The recognition of People for Animals Rescue Centre, Wardha shall be revoked by the Central Zoo Authority, at any point of time if the Rescue Centre Operator is found not complying with the stipulated conditions.

The rescue centre should maintain record of birth, acquisitions, deaths and disposal of animals of each species in collection in the format as prescribed by the CZA and the same should be submitted to the CZA by 30th April of each year in the format as prescribed.

With immediate effect.

A half yearly report regarding progress made in implementation of the aforesaid conditions should be submitted to the Central Zoo Authority.

Grant of recognition to People for Animals – Shelter House at Pipri Taluk, District Wardha as "a Rescue Centre" beyond 30th April, 2013 would be considered on the basis of compliance of the conditions stated above and general performance of the zoo.

The recognition to the People for Animals – Shelter House at Pipri Taluk, District Wardha shall be revoked by the Central Zoo Authority, at any point of time if the Zoo Operator is found not complying with the stipulated conditions.


