The evaluation of the Asiad Circus was carried out on 16.06.2013 by the Divisional Director, Social Forestry Division, Pilibhit and the evaluation report of the as submitted the evaluating officer was considered by the Technical Committee of the Central Zoo Authority in its 67th Meeting has decided to grant of renewal of recognition to "captive animal facility" of 2 (0:2) Indian elephants in Asiad Circus as a 'zoo' under Section 38H (3) of the Wild Life (Protection) Act, 1972 for a period up to 30th September, 2014 subject to the compliance of the following directives under the Recognition of Zoo Rules, 2009 and mid-term evaluation of the circus:-
