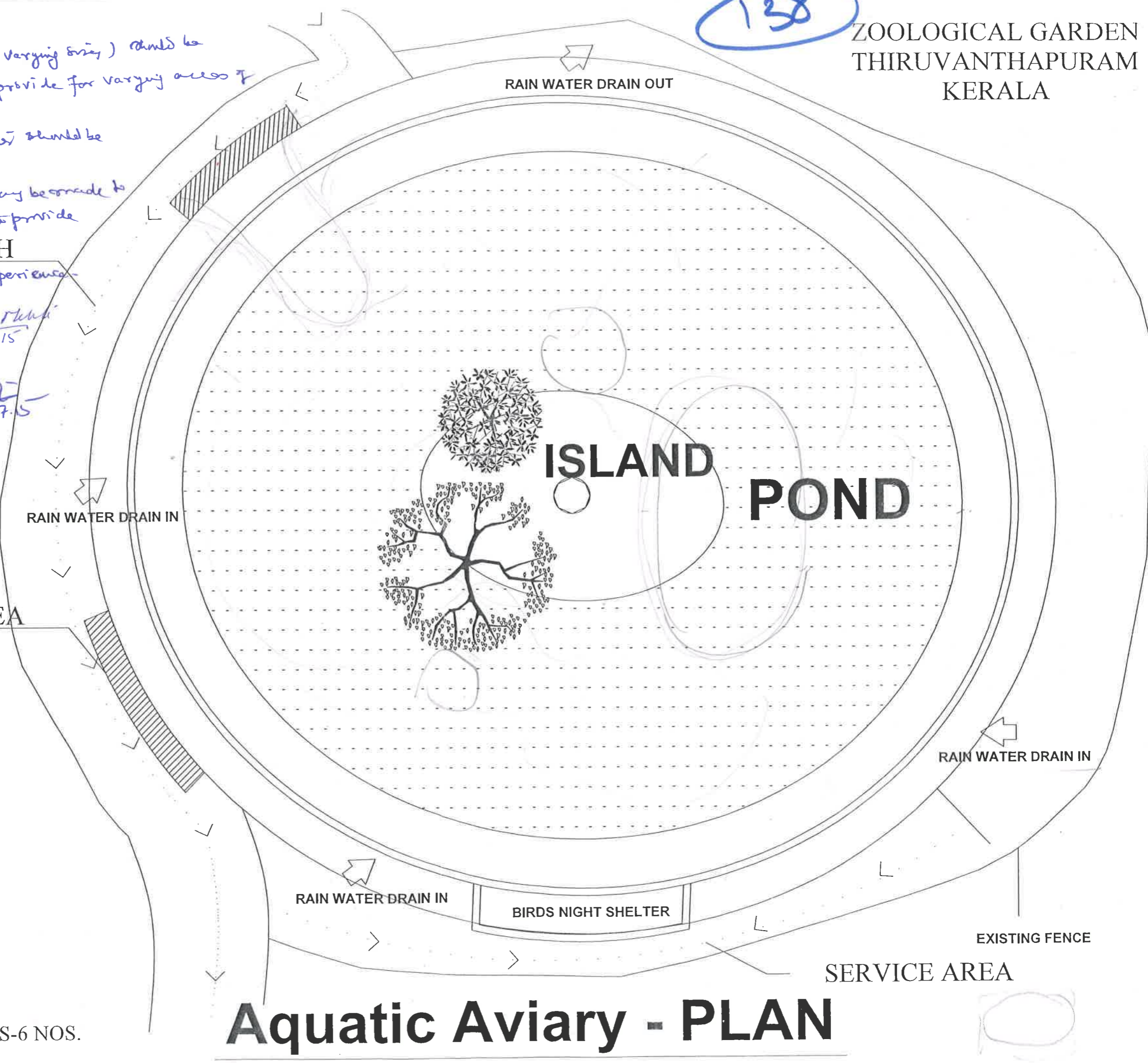

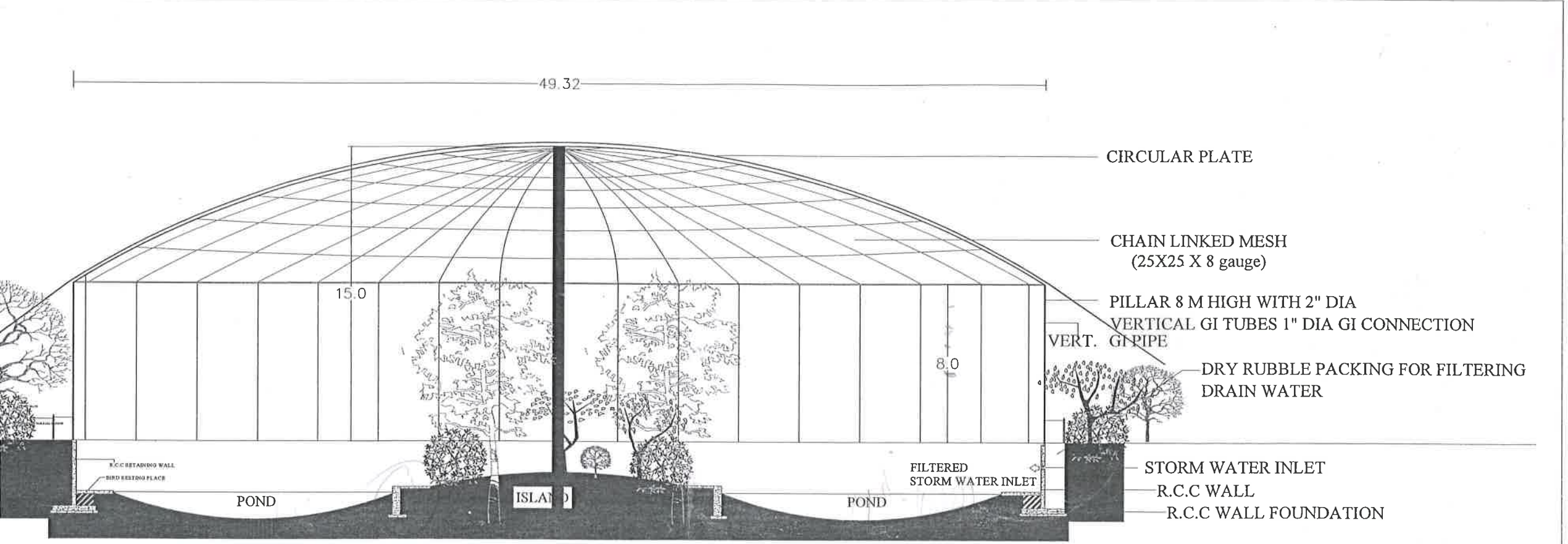
Aquatic Aviary - PLAN
