Sub:- Proposed design for the construction of various enclosures at Nagaland Zoological Park, Rangapahar.

Ref:- Your letter No. CWL/Gen/42/1106 dated 26th February 2013.

Sir,

Reference is invited to the above cited correspondence.

The designs for the construction of various enclosures at Nagaland Zoological Park, Rangapahar was placed before the Meeting of the Expert Group on Zoo Designing of the Central Zoo Authority held on 1st March 2013.

The Members scrutinized the designs and following observations were made:-

1. Capped langur exhibit

The design was scrutinized and not approved, however the following observations were made:-

- (i) The moat width to be reduced and kept limited to viewing area and rest of the perimeter of the paddock should be covered by the chain-link mesh of 5 mt. high with MS plate of 1.5 meter wide and 60 degree angle.
- (ii) The viewing side may be shifted to the either to left or right side of the exhibit not opposite to feeding cells.

2. Tiger exhibit

The design was scrutinized and approved subject to the following modifications:-

- (i) The kraal should be kept outside the paddock area.
- (ii) There should be no store with the keeper's gallery, instead there can be provision for keepers wardrobe.
- (iii) The details of the animal house and night cells should be shown clearly and all dimensions should be readable.
- (iv) Cross-section of house should also be submitted.
- (v) Size of the sliding door should not be more than 75mm X 1m high.

3. Jungle Cat exhibit

The design was scrutinized and found incomplete, the members desired that the details on the animals houses, dimensions and cross-section of the animal enclosure should be submitted.

4. Barking deer exhibit

The design was scrutinized and approved subject to the following modifications:-

- (i) The kraal to be kept outside the paddock area.
- (ii) The entry from paddock to the kraal should be made from feeding cells.
- (iii) Viewing area for visitors should be shifted on a side, and any case should not be kept opposite to feeding cells.

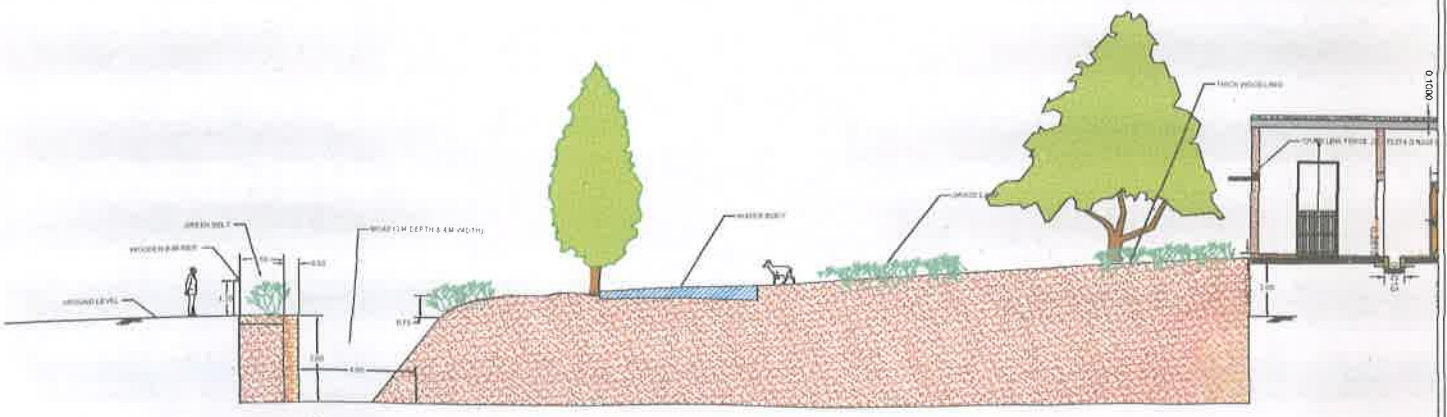
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BARKING DEER EXHIBIT (LAYOUT PLAN)

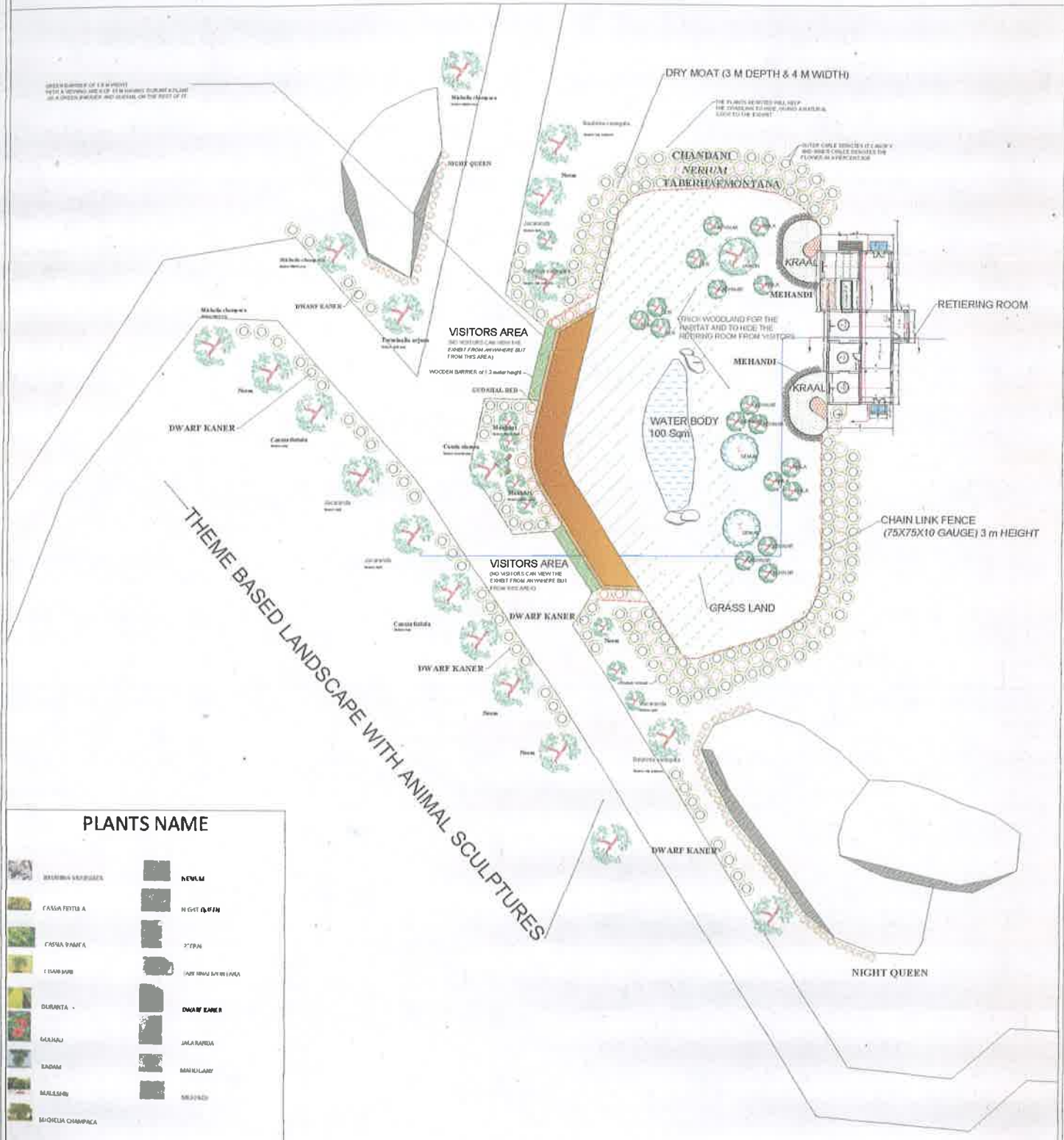

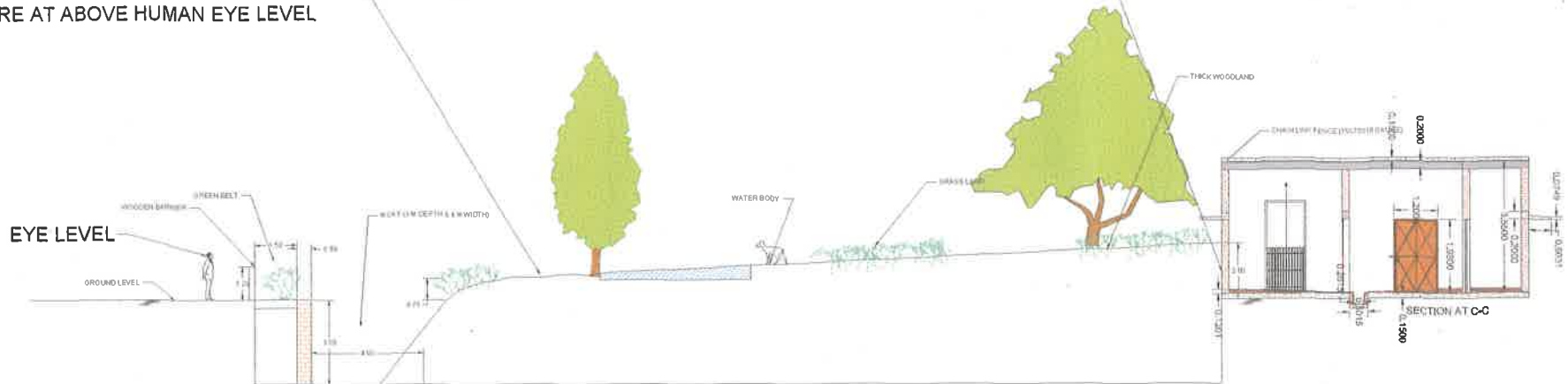
