Sir/ Madam,

Please refer to the circular at Ref. No. (ii), policy on establishment of Dolphinarium in the country, the Ministry of Environment and Forests, Government of India has decided to widen the same for housing of Marine Mammals also in the country.

This has approval of the Hon'ble Minister of State (Independent Charge), Ministry of Environment and Forests, Government of India, New Delhi dated 05.08.2013.

The State Governments are advised to reject any such proposal for Dolphinarium to any person/ persons, organizations, Government agencies, private or public enterprises that involves import, capture of cetacean species including Marine Mammals to establish for commercial entertainment, private or public exhibition and interaction purposes whatsoever.
