New Delhi, the 15th November 1995

S.O. 3131.—In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (c) of sub-section (1) of section 38B of the Wild Life (Protection) Act, 1972 (53 of 1972), the Central Government hereby makes the following rules to amend the Central Zoo Authority (Officers and Other Employees) Recruitment Rules, 1994, namely:—

1. (i) These rules may be called the Central Zoo Authority Officers and (Other Employees) Recruitment (Amendment) Rules, 1995.

(ii) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. In the Schedule to the Central Zoo Authority (Officers and Other Employees) Recruitment Rules, 1995;—

(a) in column 13 of serial number 6,7,8, 9 and 10, for the existing entry at item number 2, the following entry shall respectively be substituted, namely:—

"2 An Officer of the Ministry of Environment and Forests not below the rank of Deputy Secretary";

(b) after serial number 5 relating to the post of Accountant and the entries relating thereto, the following serial number and the entries shall be inserted, namely:—

Note : The crucial date for determining the age limit shall be the closing date for receipt of applications from candidates in India (and not the closing date prescribed for those in Assam, Meghalaya, Arunachal Pradesh, Mizoram, Manipur, Nagaland, Tripura, Sikkim, Ladakh division of Jammu and Kashmir State, Labaul Spiti district and Pangri sub-division of Chamba district of Himachal Pradesh, Andaman and Nicobar Islands or Lakshadweep).

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Whether age and educational qualifications prescribed for direct recruits will apply in the case of promotees. Period of probation, if any. Method of recruitment whether by direct recruitment or by promotion or by deputation/transfer and percentage of the vacancies to be filled by various methods.

Not applicable	Two years	Direct recruitment Note : Vacancies caused by the incumbent being away on transfer on deputation or long illness or leave or under other circumstances for a period of one year or more, may be filled by transfer on deputation basis from officials of the Central/State Government/Public Sector Undertakings/Autonomous Bodies; (a)(i) holding analogous post on regular basis or (ii) 7 with 4 years regular service in posts in the scale of 1400-2300/2600 or equivalent; and (b) possessing the qualifications prescribed for direct recruits under column 8.

In case of recruitment by promotion/deputation/transfer, grades from which promotion/deputation/transfer to be made. If a Departmental Promotion Committee exists, what is its composition. Circumstances in which Union Public Service Commission is to be consulted in making recruitment.
