CIRCULAR

Subject:- Acquisition or transfer of animals by a Circus - regarding

It is hereby directed that operators of all Circuses should strictly adhere to provision made under Section 38I of the Wildlife (Protection) Act, 1972 which reads as:-

- 1. 'Subject to the other provisions of this Act, no zoo shall acquire, sell or transfer any wild animal or captive animal specified in Schedules I and II except with the previous permission of the Authority.'
- 2. 'No zoo shall acquire, sell or transfer any wild or captive animal except from or to a recognised zoo.'

The Indian elephant (*Elephas maximus*), being Schedule I animal under Wildlife (Protection) Act, 1972, housed in a recognized Circus should not be acquired /transferred without permission of the Central Zoo Authority. Any violation of the statutory provision shall invite action against the Circus and its operator under Wildlife (Protection) Act, 1972.
