Sir/ Madam,

It has come to the notice of this Authority that some zoos are engaged in the sale of zoo animals. In this context, while inviting your kind attention to the references cited above, it is reiterated that zoos are not authorized to carry out trade in any wildlife species since the same amounts to violation of the statutory provision, National Zoo Policy and advisories issued by the Government of India.

The State Forest Department, through the Chief Wildlife Warden, may ensure suitable action against the defaulting zoos, and under no circumstances ownership certificates should be issued for animals acquired from zoos.
