CIRCULAR

Sub:- Submission of inventory of the animals housed in Zoos.

Sir/ Madam,

It is mandatory under Rule 10(42) of the Recognition of Zoo Rules, 1992 that every Zoo should submit the record of the births, acquisitions, disposals and deaths of animals housed at the Zoos to the Central Zoo Authority.

On perusal of the information received from various Zoos by this Authority it has been noticed that at many times the information is not submitted on time or incomplete or being sent every month/ quarter. Keeping in view of the above, following guidelines are being issued for the submission of inventory of the animals housed in Zoos:-

- 1. The inventory of <u>all the animals</u> housed in each Zoo as on 31st March of every year shall be submitted to the Central Zoo Authority by 30th April of the same year in the format prescribed by the Central Zoo Authority. A soft copy in access format may also be sent along with the inventory report either by e.mail or in floppy/CD. The said format preparatory software sill be sent to your shortly along with the instruction manual. Also a proforma at Annexure I is to be filled and returned to this office at the earliest.
- 2. (a) The inventory of <u>Schedule I & II animals</u> [as listed in Wild Life (Protection) Act, 1972)] housed in each Zoo for every quarter (1st April to 30th June, 1st July to 30th September, 1st October to 31st December, 1st January to 31st March) shall be submitted to the Central Zoo Authority within 15 day from the end of quarter.

(b) The inventory details with regard to hybrid lions/ tigers and albino animals should not be included while submitting data with the quarterly report.

The information with regard to the death of endangered species being housed at the Zoo should be reported to the Central Zoo Authority within 24 hrs. The information with regard to death of common animals is not required by this office immediately however, the same may be submitted at the end of year along with the inventory of all animals.

It is requested that the Zoo Operator should strictly adhere with the aforesaid guidelines while submitting the inventory details.
