**OFFICE MEMORANDUM**

**Subject: Submission of Statutory Annual Report by the Zoos to the CZA – Format thereof – regarding.**

It is to inform that as per the provisions under the Rule 11(2) of the Recognition of Zoo Rules, 2009, all zoos recognized by this Authority under Sec 38 H of the Wild Life (Protection) Act, 1972 are required to submit an Annual Report to this Authority by 30<sup>th</sup> June every year. The relevant Rule is quoted below:

*'Every zoo shall submit an annual report of its activities and compliance of the conditions stipulated by Central Zoo Authority for each financial year to the Central Zoo Authority by 30<sup>th</sup> day of June of the year.'*

In the absence of any prescribed format in this regard, the Annual Reports received from the recognised zoos were not uniform and many times the relevant information were not being incorporated in the Annual Reports of the zoos.

Accordingly, the matter was considered in the 85<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Technical Committee of the Central Zoo Authority held on 26<sup>th</sup> March, 2018 and a format for submission of the Annual Report by the Zoos was considered by the Committee and recommended for consideration and approval of the Central Zoo Authority.

The Central Zoo Authority in its 31<sup>st</sup> Meeting held on 26<sup>th</sup> June, 2018 approved the format for submission of the Annual Report to the Central Zoo Authority under the Rule 11(2) of the Recognition of Zoo Rules, 2009.

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A copy of the approved format for submission of the Annual Report to the Central Zoo Authority by the zoos is attached herewith for information and necessary action. In view of the above, the Annual Report of the zoo shall be submitted to this Authority in the prescribed format.

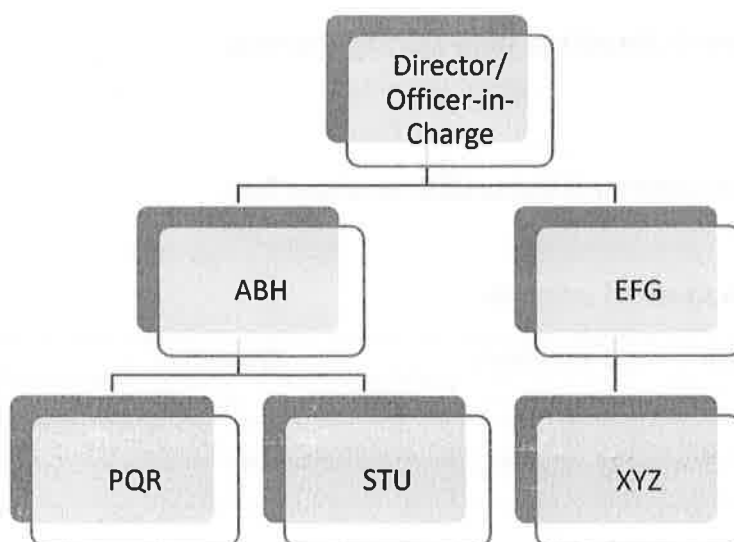
“Zoo Operator” means the person who has ultimate control over the affairs of the zoos provided that\_\_\_\_\_

II. in the case of a company, any director, manager, secretary or other officer, who is in-charge of and responsible to the company for the affairs of the zoo; or

III. In case of zoo owned or controlled by the Central Government or any State Government or Union Territory Administration or any Trust or Society funded by the Central Government or a State Government or a Union Territory Administration, the Secretary of the concerned Department of that Government, or as the case may be the Union Territory Administration, shall be deemed to be the Zoo Operator.

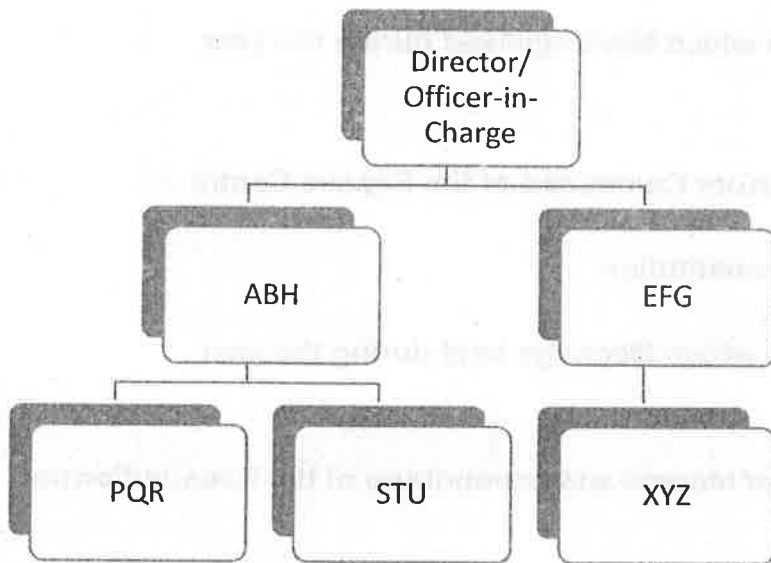
