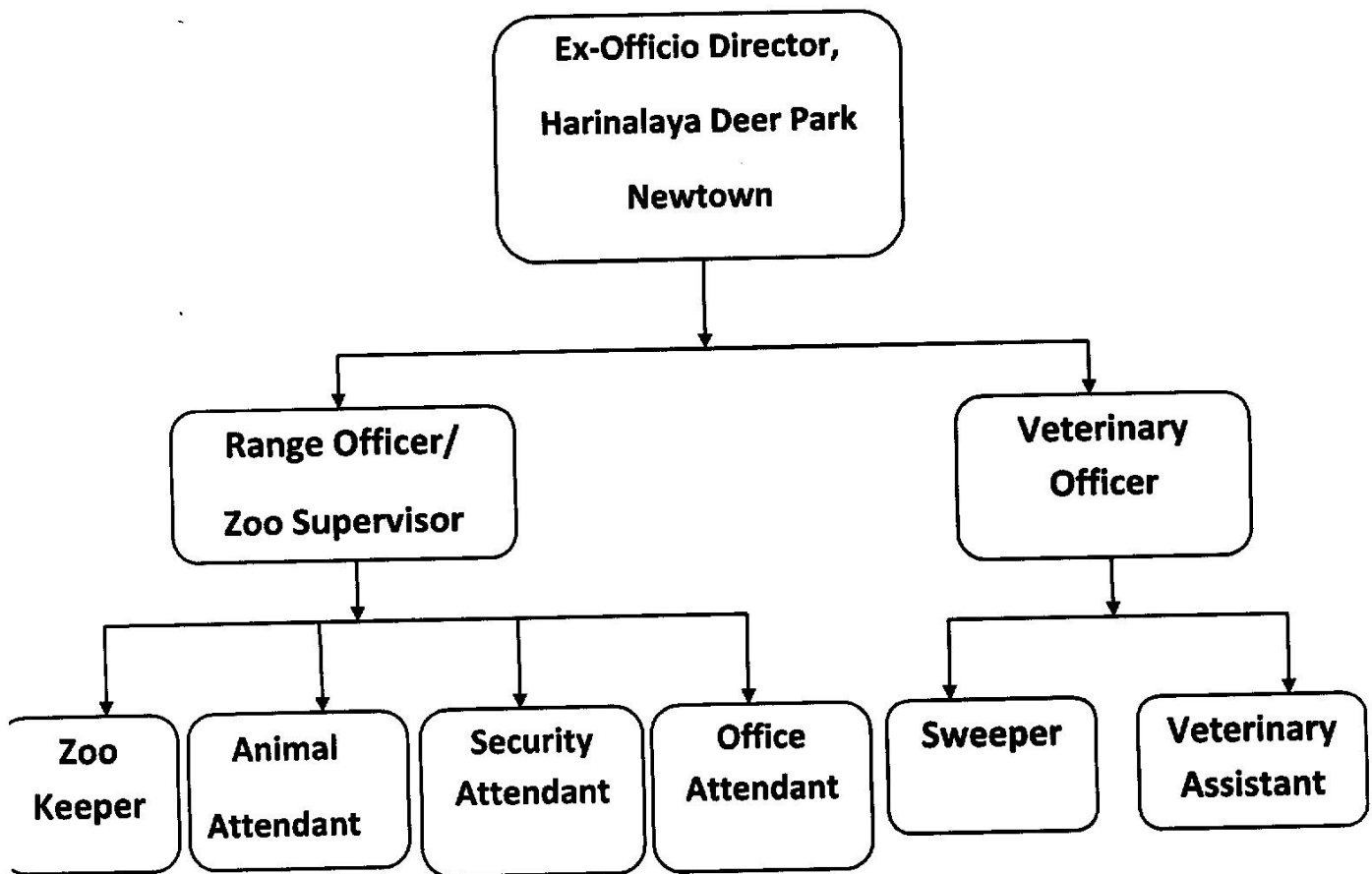
“Zoo Operator” means the person who has ultimate control over the affairs of the Zoo provided that _____

3. In the case of zoo owned or controlled by the Central Government or any State Government or Union Territory Administration or any Trust or Society funded by the Central Government or a State Government

Or a Union Territory Administration, the Secretary of the concerned Department of that Government or as the case may be the Union Territory Administration, shall be deemed to be the Zoo Operator.

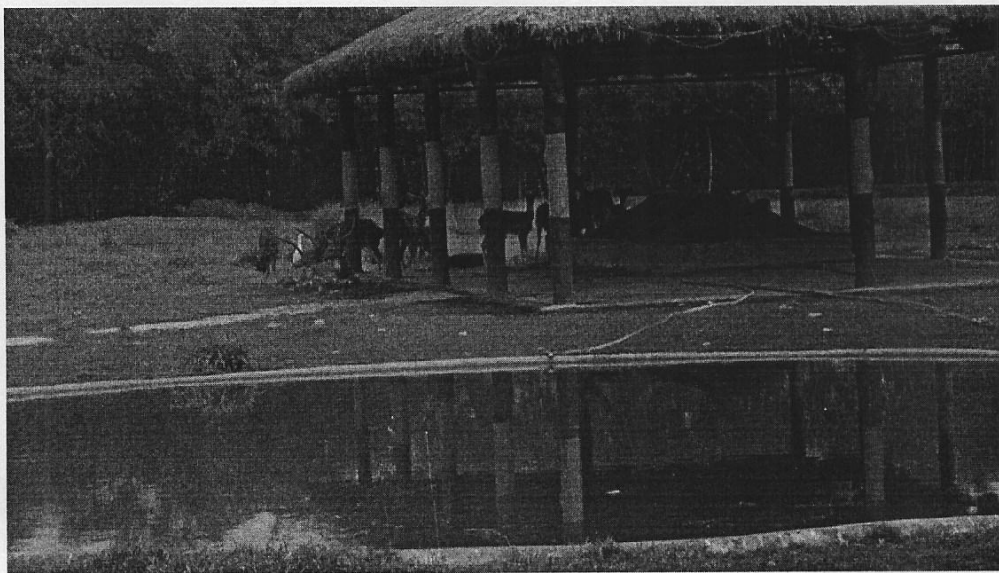

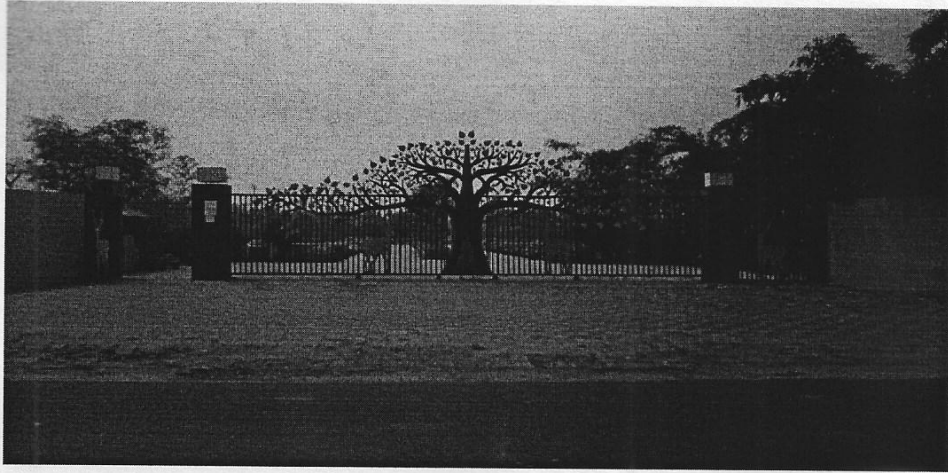

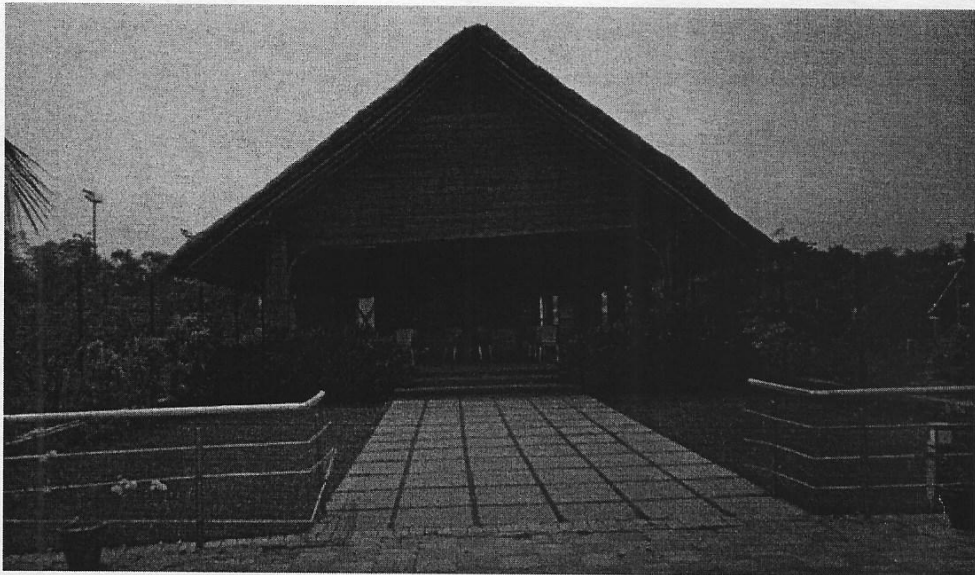
Barking Deer
