

## Report of the Officer-in-charge

### 1. History of the Zoo

**Bardhaman Zoological Park** erstwhile Ramnabagan Mini Zoo has been developed within the Ramnabagan Wild Life Sanctuary, a natural forest patch flourished during the feudal reign of Rajas and Maharajas of Bardhaman Taluk. After the promulgation of Estate Acquisition act, it was handed over to the Forest Department of West Bengal for management. The area was declared as reserved forests vide Notification No. 2275-For. Dt. 07.06.1960. In the year 1978, a Deer Park with the introduction of 6 nos. of deer was established in this reserve forest patch. Subsequently, the whole area of 14.724 ha. has been declared as Wild Life Sanctuary vide G.O. No. 4345/For-11B-7/80 dt. 30.09.1981.

As per the provisions laid down in Wild Life Protection Act, 1972 (Amended), it is mandatory to obtain permission for setting up of any rescue center or zoo from Central Zoo Authority, Govt. of India. Accordingly, as per statutory application submitted for the purpose, Ramnabagan Wild Life Sanctuary was recognised as a Mini Zoo vide Central Zoo Authority's memo number F. No. 22-67/2004-CZA(473)(M) dt. 10.02.2006. Renewal of recognition to the Bardhaman Zoological Park, Ramnabagan, Burdwan as a small category zoo **has been granted upto February 3rd, 2029** Vide CZA's Memo No. 22-67/2004-CZA(473)(NE), Computer No. 147074 dt. 17-03-2026.

**Area:** The total area of Bardhaman Zoological Park is 14.044 ha. located in mouza Baburbag, J.L. No.40, P.S. Burdwan (Sadar) within the municipal limits of Burdwan town (Longitude – 87.30<sup>0</sup> east, Latitude – 23.15<sup>0</sup> north and mean sea level – 20 m.) Soil is alluvial plain of Western Gangetic basin. Topography is flat.

### 2. VISION

The vision of the Bardhaman Zoological Park, Bardhaman is to provide a glimpse of wild animals and birds of the Gangetic plains to the general public for developing a healthy relationship between animals and human beings.

### 3. MISSION

The mission of the Bardhaman Zoological Park, Bardhaman is conservation of representative wild animals of the Gangetic plains and to aware the general public on sustainable conservation of wild fauna which are under severe threat due to biotic interference.

### 4. Objective

- i) Conservation education and awareness generation of endangered spp. among general people to develop a healthy relationship between animals and human being.
- ii) Research & education by college and university students of Bardhaman University situated close to the Zoological Park.
- iii) To maintain gene pool of wild animals and birds.
- iv) To provide a safe abode temporarily to the rescued wild animals, confiscated, injured, orphaned and sick animals to release afterwards in nature.
- v) To protect animals from immediate and impending danger to their lives.
- vi) For research on the various aspects of ecology and behaviour of wild animals.


