




As conservation education is the main objective of the zoos, we also organize various educational programmes to reach as many people as possible.

During the previous year Construction of Visitor's Shed, Store room, Parking Sheds, Fencing work ,Repair of Hippo Enclosure ,Fixing of New Signages Steel Boards, Wall Painting Work etc. has been done. More over plantation work has been done for the beatification of zoo.

We have successfully provided good facilities to zoo animals and visitors. I take this opportunity to thank everyone who has dedicated their time and hard work supporting me towards the development of the zoo.

2. History of the Zoo –

Bhiwani Zoo was set up in 1982 but because of its poor condition the state Government decided to close it down. Later on with the special efforts by Smt. Kiran Choudhry, the then Hon'ble Minister of Forests, Haryana, this zoo was revived by CZA, New Delhi in Sept.2006 and some more enclosures were constructed in this zoo under extension program. The total area of this zoo is 4.44 hectare (10.97 acres). At present the animals housed in this zoo are Panther, Lion, Himalayan Black bear, Crocodile, Gharial, Fox, Spotted Deer, Sambar, Chinkara, Hippopotamus, Red Jungle Fowl, Cockatiel, Parakeets, etc.



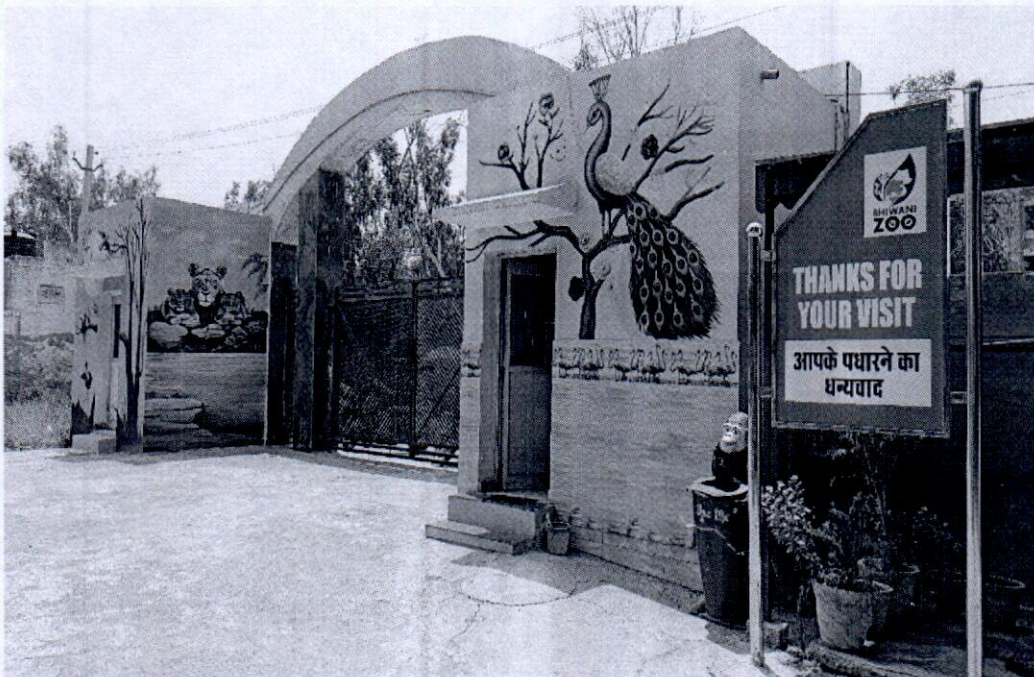
Main Gate of the Bhiwani Zoo

- e) To collect and collate the scientific data on the biology behavior and health care of animals housed in the zoo and use the same in future management of the zoo.

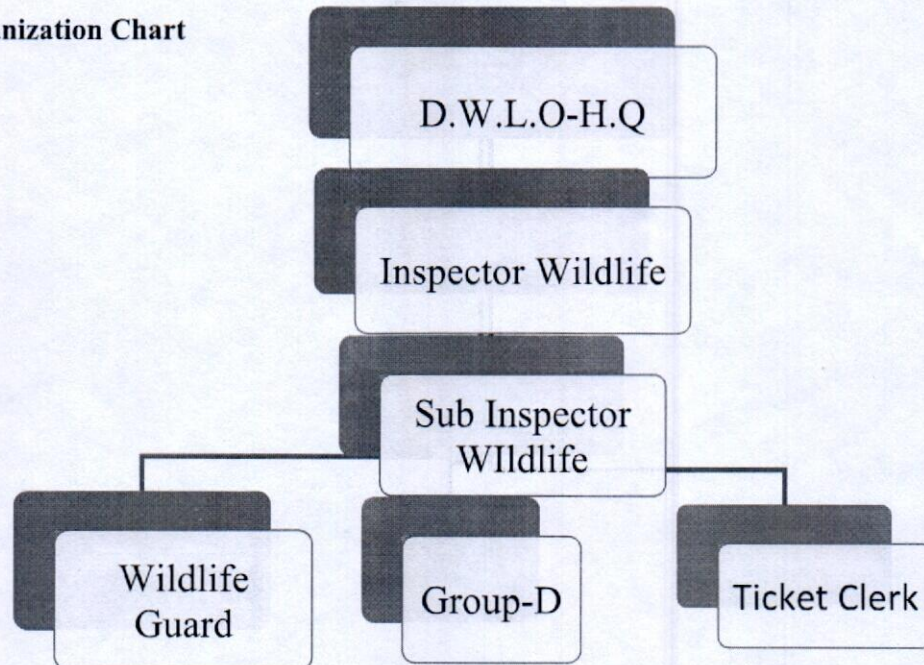

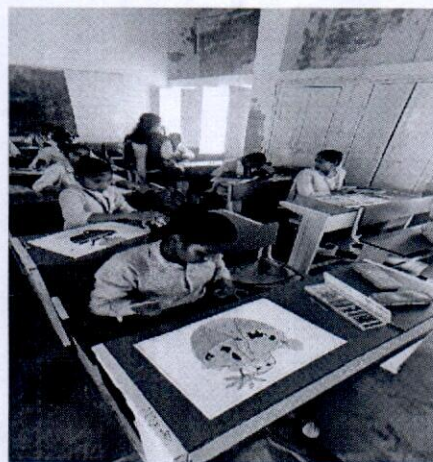

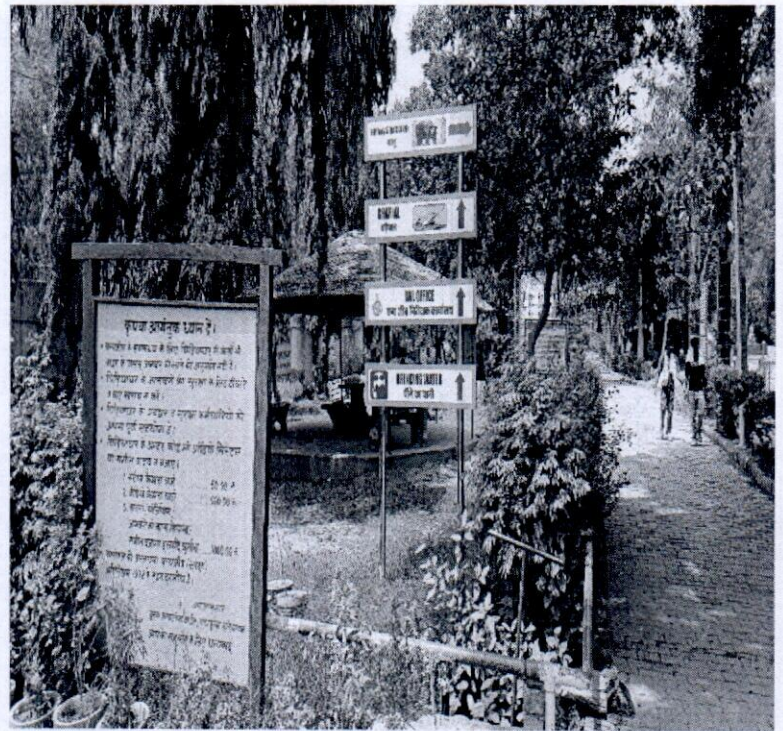

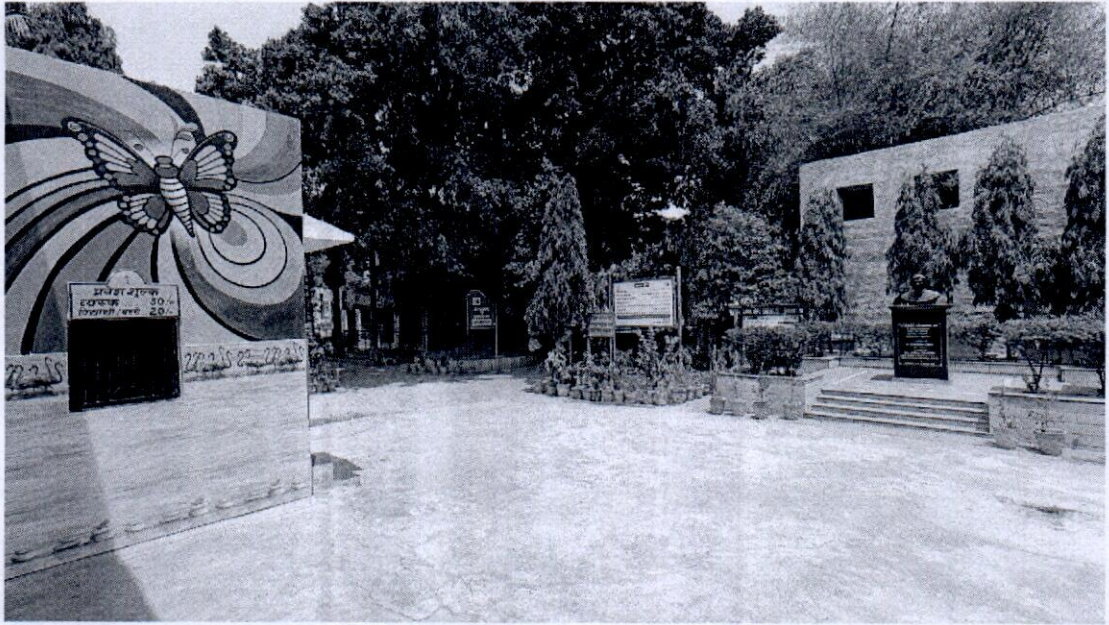


PAINTING/Quiz Competition during Wildlife Week Celebration



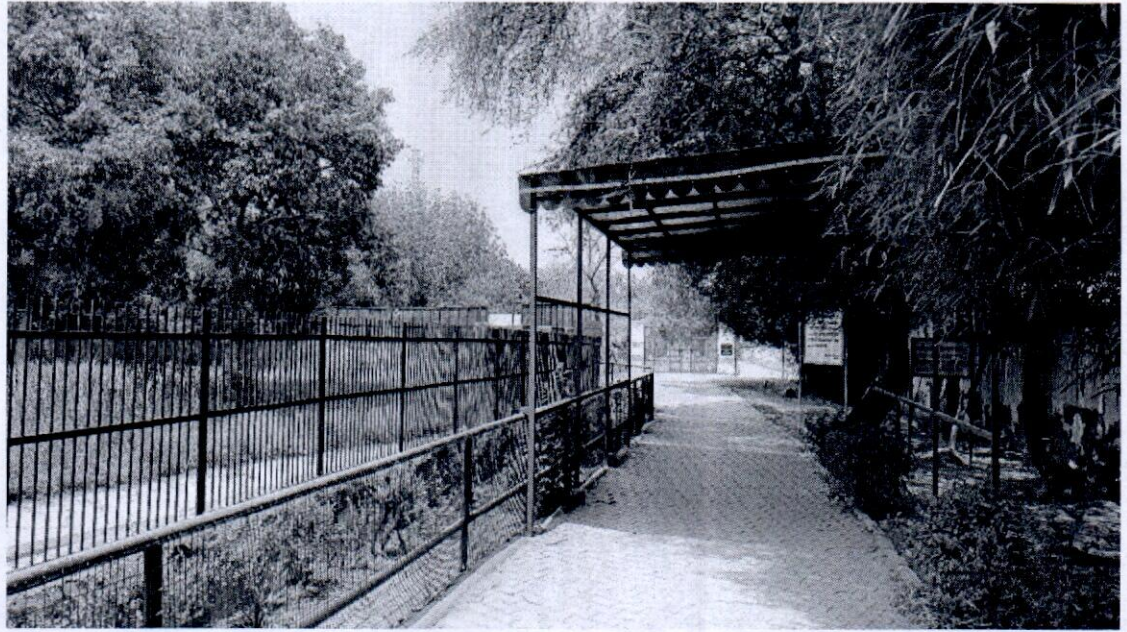

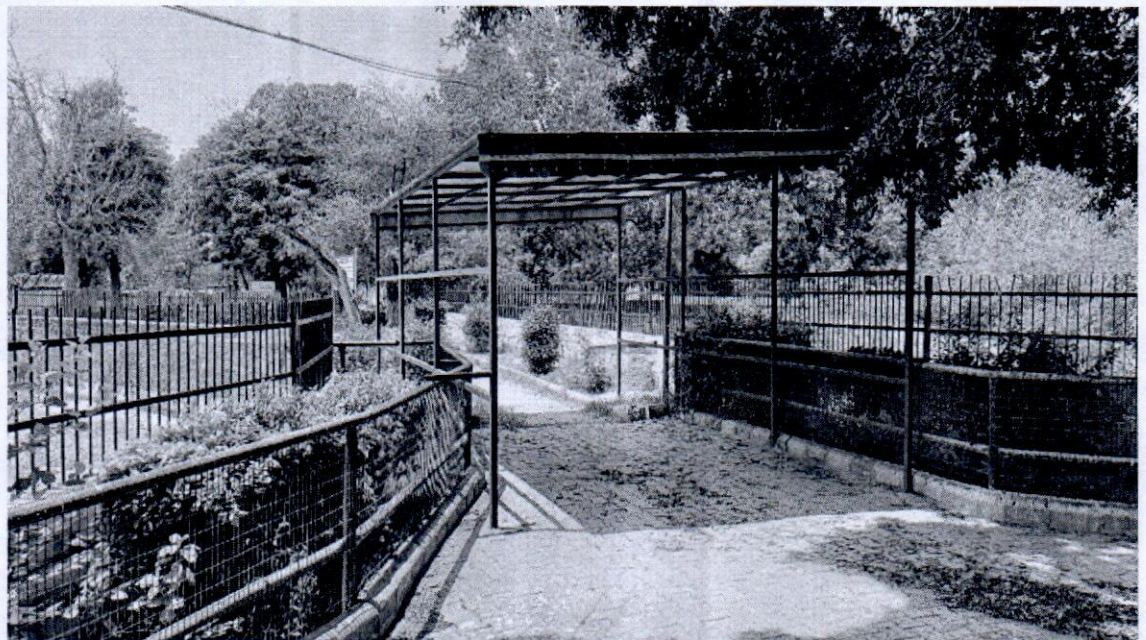


Wall Paintings at Bhiwani Zoo

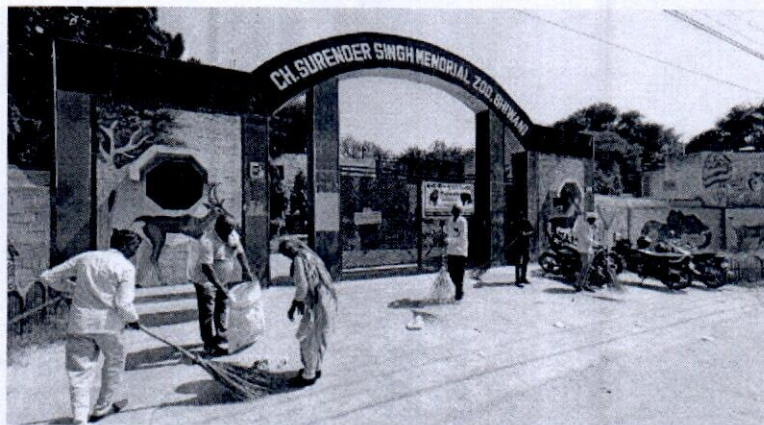
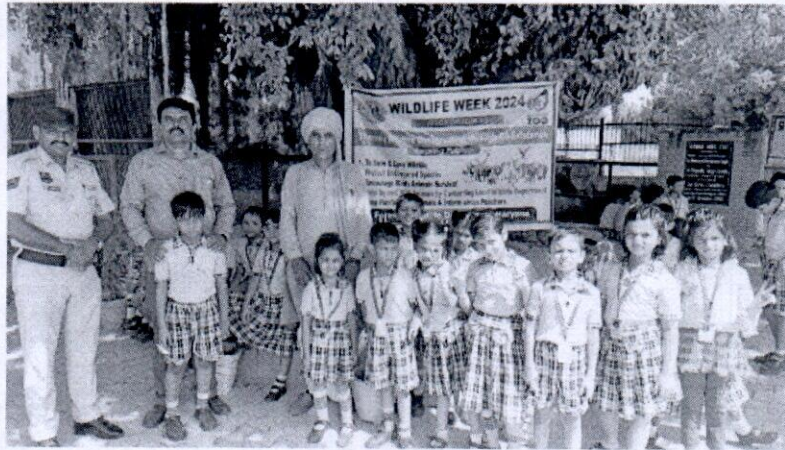




VISITOR'S SHED at Bhiwani Zoo
