1. Report of the Officer-in-charge

Birsa Mirg Vihar, Kalamati was established in 1982. This is the only Zoo situated at the Khunti District of Jharkhand. Main aim of the zoo is to creating awareness ex-situ conservation of the wildlife which is most important during the day today conditions.

2. History of the Zoo

Birsa Mrig Vihar, Kalamati was created by Govt. of Bihar vide sanctioned order No. 52 dated 02-01-1982 at an initial cost of Rs. 13.775 lakhs under the Tribal Area Sub Plan of the Department of Forest and Environment.

Birsa Mrig Vihar, Kalamati was inaugurated by the then forest Hon"ble Minister Sri. Bhukla Bhagat on 05-03-1987.

Birsa Mrig Vihar, Kalamati has been recognized as "Mini Zoo" by CZA in the year 2009 vide his letter no F. No 19-131/93-CZA(51)(M)-dated 19.05.2009.

3. Vision

- a. Ensuring the welfare of natural resources through conservation of biodiversity.
- b. The park is to provide a glimpse of wild animals to the general public for developing a healthy relationship between animal and human beings.
- c. To promote conservation of our invaluable faunal resources through display, care and awareness. It is committed towards protection and conservation of species and strives for a peaceful co-existence to development and conservation.
- d. To provide protection and management for Spotted deer and Sambhar in the surrounding forest in a natural habitat.
- e. To create awareness among public, Students on Wild Life and its habitat.


"Zoo Operator" means the person who has ultimate control over the affairs of the zoos provided that

In case of zoo owned or controlled by the Central Government or any State Government or Union Territory Administration or any Trust or Society funded by the Central Government or a State Government or a Union Territory Administration, the Secretary of the concerned Department of that Government, or as the case may be the Union Territory Administration, shall be deemed to be the Zoo Operator.
