#### 2)History of the Zoo

Mini Zoo Bir Talab Bathinda was established in 1978 within Bir Talab Block Forest. Total Area of Bir Talab Forest is 161 Acre. Started in a modest way by Red Cross Society, Bathinda but later on it was adopted by Punjab Forest & Wildlife Preservation Department in the year 1982. Situated about 6 KM away from Bathinda town on Bathinda Multania Road and spread over approximately 10.40 hect. Area. The Mini Zoo is situated in the Block Protected Forest.

#### 3)Vision

So many animals and Birds (Detailed in Sr no 26) in Mini Zoo Bir Talab. Main vegetation of the area includes elements of dry deciduous forests dominated by Mulberry (Morus alba), Neem (Azadirachta indica), Arjun (Terminalia arjuna), Shisham (Dalbergia sissoo) and other species. Neem (Azadirachta indica), Burma Drek (Melia composita) plantation has also been taken up. There are some research plots of casurina , Ecualyptus, teak, Maleyna , Khair etc. species. In all there are more than Fifty two different species of trees standing in the Bir Talab block forest. The fauna found free ranging within the Block Forest are Blackbuck (Antelope cervicapra), bluebull (Boselaphus tragocamelus), snakes, rhesus macaques, Longeared Hedgehog (Jhaha), Mongoose etc.

#### 4)Mission

To educate the people regarding wildlife, their habitat, food habits and status etc.

#### 5) Objective

Ex-situ maintenance and conservation of endangered species in captivity. To enhance knowledge of animal behavior by conducting research and study on management of wildlife in captivity and to educate the people regarding wildlife, their habitat, food habits and status etc.

#### 18) Development works carried out in the zoo during the year

#### a) Leapord Enclosure

The malwa's first Leapor Enclosure has been established in Mini Zoo BIR TALAB this year. The second opened leapord Enclosure of Indian has been constructed under CZA guidelines. It is fully set up with technical squeeze cell, keeper room, keeper gallery, animals cells and crawl area. It's inaugurated by Divisional Forest Officer Bathinda Harbhajan Singh on 10 Oct 2017. Leapords are the only carnivores habitat kept in mini zoo BirTalab which has become a majar cause of attraction vistorstowarda zoo.

#### b) **Battery Operated Vehicle**

The Punjab Govt. Provides battery operated vehicle for prevention measures of noise and air pollution used for staff service for up keeping animal in Mini Zoo BIR TALAB.

#### 19) Education and wareness programmes during the year

The prime objective of Mini Zoo of Mini Zoo is educating the visitors about wildlife conservation. Organization various education activities throughout the year with Support of local NGO's and sponsors. It encourages the youth to conserve and use it sustainably, especially the students of school and colleges. More than 8000 students were made aware of biodiversity and wildlife conservation through the above programs. More than 300 tree saplings were also planted during this period inside the Zoo campus. Major awareness activities undertaken during the year were:

A. World Environmet Day 2019: On occasion of World Environment Day on 5<sup>th</sup> June 2019, the MINI ZOO Park has embarked on a mission to enforce a ban on the entry of plastic botteles and polythene begs into the Zoo and has put in place stringent anti-littn measures within Zoo premises. In celebrity on world environment there are more than 400 plants of different species has been planted in Mini Zoo BIR TALAB to create Biodiversity.

B. Wildlife Week Celebrations 2019: Like every year, the Mini Zoo cum deer safari BIR TALAB was celebration from 3<sup>rd</sup> to 7<sup>th</sup> October, 2019 by organizing an array of events including best Eco club Award, Inter School Essay Competition, Inter School Debate Competition. The celebration was formally inaugurated by the chief guest forest range officer SH PAWAN SHRIDHAR to create Biodiversity.

- a) Ecoligical enrichment for Captive animals like caves ans bamboo platforms in display areas of leapords enclosure, Re-do of breesding hut of Indian peacock, and plantation of trees inside enclosure for biodiversity measures.
- b) List of wanted surplus animals and animals Collection plan of the Zoo has been prepared and finalized.
- c) All the birds and animals vaccinated against feline Pan Leucopenia, Calcivirus, Herpes Virus and Rabies infection using Biofel PCHR vaccine under annual vaccination Schedule. The cloven footed animals were vaccination against FMD every nine months.
- d) Captive animals and birds were de-wormedof Endo and Ecto parasites.

e) In summer season all the birds and animal were aerviced with artificial raito maintain temperature level.

#### 22) Research Work carried out and publications

Though structured research activity is not done at present by the zoo staff, researchers from various scientific institutions/Universities do take interest in conducting research on captive animals.

#### 23) Conservation Breeding Programme of the Zoo

The Mini Zoo largely has deer species in its collection. There is thus a need to focus on conservation breeding of some of the endangered deer species like Hog deer and barking deer etc.
