The area of Deer Park Hisar is 48 acre. It is Located about 6 km from Bus stand & 8 km from railway Station. There are 109 Animals which are bign displayed. These include Black Buck, Sambar. Chittal and Chinkara. They are Breeding regularly. There is a designated area for visitors & view the animals. Entry is free for visitors. Zoo Providing free Parking Facility. The animals are look after will very well. One veterinary form veterinary Hospital visits when required. There is need to have water supply system from Public health department & electricity from electricity department.

2. **History of the Zoo:-**

Deer Park Hisar is situated on Hisar – Dhansu Road at Hisar. It was started in 1970-71, with in a patch of 27 acres of natural mixed forest. Now the area of the Deer Park Hisar is 48 acre including 6 acres fodder plot.

Deer Park Hisar is 6 km. away from Bus stan Hisar and 8 km from Railway station Hisar. The Deer Park is well connected to Delhi, Chandigarh, Jaipur and other important cites by road. There is a good network of approachable roads form all sides of the Deer Park. Delhi is the nearest Airport which is 170 km.

3. **Vision**

To impart conservation massage to the visitors.

4. **Mission**

To develop amongst visitors an empathy for wild animals and motivate then to support the cause of conservation.

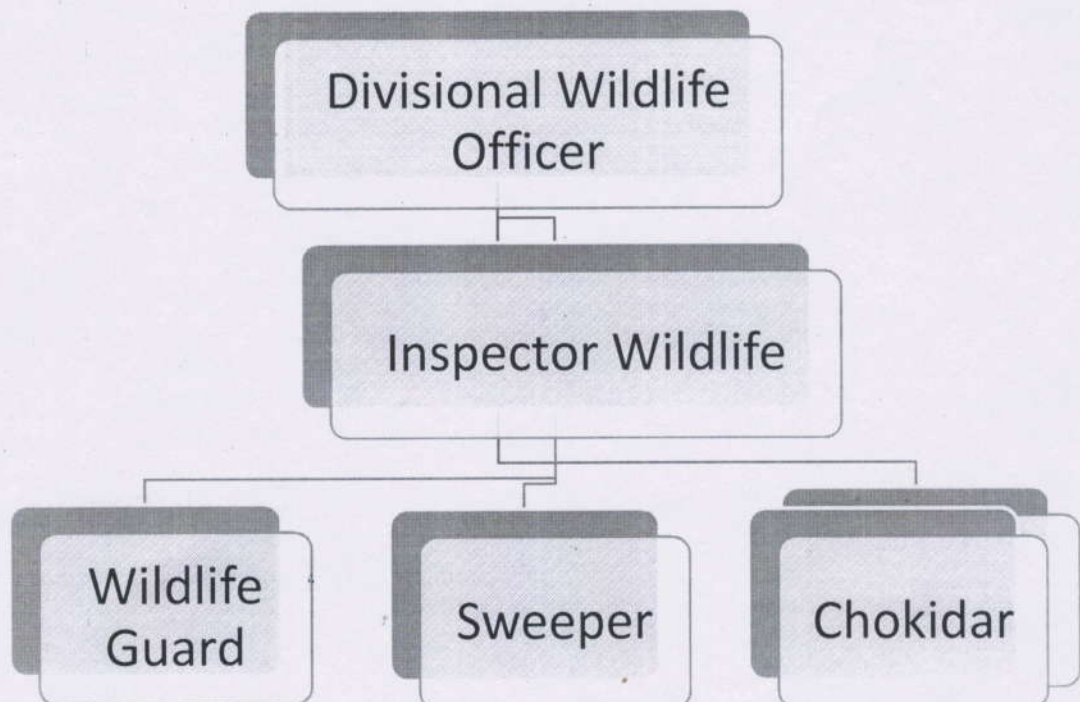


