Dear Readers,



2. History of the deer park –

Deer Park , Hisar Was Started In 1970-1971 In A Patch Of 27 Acres Of Forest Land. There After Its Area Was Increased To 46.86 Acres By Adding Forest Land Of Bir-Hisar . This Park Is 6km Bus Stand And 8 Km From Railways Station Or Airport Hisar 4.5 Km . The Deer Park Was Accorded Status Of Deer Park Under Section 38h Of Wild Life Protection Act-1972.

The Vision Of The Deer Park Is To Impart Conservation Message To Park Visitors. It Also Aims To Educate And Generate Awareness Among General Public With A View To Develop Relationship Between Animals And Human Beings.

Deer Park Is A Part Of 1131 Acres Of Protected Forest , Know As Bir-Hisar There Are A Number Of Wild Animals Which Includes Reptiles ,Mammals And Birds. This Area Is A Semi-Arid Zone Which Includes Flora Species Like Kikar, Ber, Jaal, Khair, And Musquits

Animals Collection Includes Chital, Sambhar, Black Buck, And Chinkara Which Are Found In The State Of Haryana. These Animals Are Displayed In A Large Enclosure Of 36.16 Acres. This Enclosure Has Abundant Tree Plantation And Adequate Of 36.16 Acres. This Enclosure Has Abundant Tree Plantation And Adequate Number Of Water Bodies And Sheds.

The Services Of Veterinary Surgeon Are Aailed From Veterinary Hospital For Care And Treatment Regularly. There Is No Entry Fees For Visitors. The Park Has Provided Toilet, Benches And Drinking Water Facilites For The Visitors.

Vision:

To create awareness about our rich fauna among general public and develop a healthy relationship between animals and human beings for maintaining a healthy ecological balance.

3. Mission-

Our mission is to develop amongst visitors an empathy for wild animals and motivate them to support the cause of conservation. This deer park strives to prevent species extinction through, habitat restoration, and raising public awareness. Deer park plays a crucial role in educating the public about wildlife. It offers a place for people to relax, enjoy nature, and connect with wildlife.

- A) Our basic objective is to maintain the deer park and to provide healthy environments to deer park
- B) To educate and motivate the society towards the conservation of wildlife, biodiversity and natural resources
- C) To provide better facilities to visitors and sensitize the local people about wild animals.

- E) To collect and collate the scientific data on the biology behavior and health care of animals housed in the deer park and use the same in future management of the deer park .

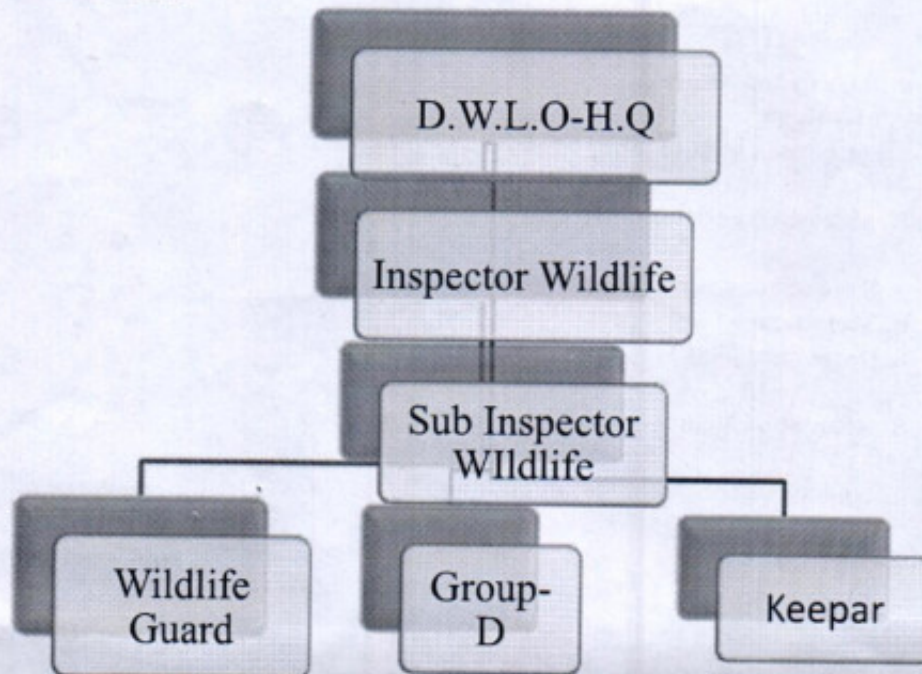

हिरण विहार, हिसार

आज से पहले हिसार जिले में राज्य प्राणी अत्यधिक संख्या में पाये जाने में। मीड हिसार में सन् 1960 में लाइंगर आखरी
 था. दे हा गया था। हिसार जिले की भौगोलिक परिस्थितियों जैसे अतिमिट 2000 से टिन्ने एवं अर्धशुष्क जलवायु के कारण
 हिरण व वृद्ध संख्या में पाये जाने में। हिसार लम्बी जार (एक लाख हिरणों का झुंड) के लिए प्रसिद्ध था। मनोरंजन एवं मीड
 के लिए जंगली जासवरों के शिकार एवं हरित क्रांति के दौरान अधिक से अधिक भूमि पर कृषि होने के कारण वन्य
 प्राणियों का आवास स्थान खत्म होने से, हिरणों की संख्या में भारी मात्रा में कमी आई। अतः लोगों को हिरणों के बारे
 जानकारी देने, उनके प्रति सहानुभूति एवं जागरूकता पैदा करने के लिए हिसार में सन् 1970-71 में हिरण विहार की
 स्थापना की गई। इस हिरण विहार में हिरणों की विभिन्न प्रजातियों जैसे कामा हिरण, चिंकारा, चीतल एवं सांभर इत्यादि
 को जन जागरूकता एवं अनुसंधान हेतु संग्रहित करने का प्रयास किया जा रहा है।



Deer Park, Hisar

Before the independence, the wildlife was found in abundance in the district Hisar. The tiger was last sighted in Bir Hisar in the year 1960. Due to unique geographical conditions like un-irrigated sand dunes and semi arid climate, black bucks were found in abundance in Hisar district. Hisar was once famous for 'lakhi dar' (a herd of hundred thousand deers). However, there has been a substantial decrease in the population of deer and their habitat due to incessant hunting for recreation and food in the past and expansion of agricultural activities during green revolution. Therefore, with a view to generate awareness and compassion towards them by educating people, the deer park was established in the year 1970-71 in Hisar. This deer park harbours various species of deer such as black buck, chinkara, cheetal and sambar for the purpose of their preservation, awareness generation and research.

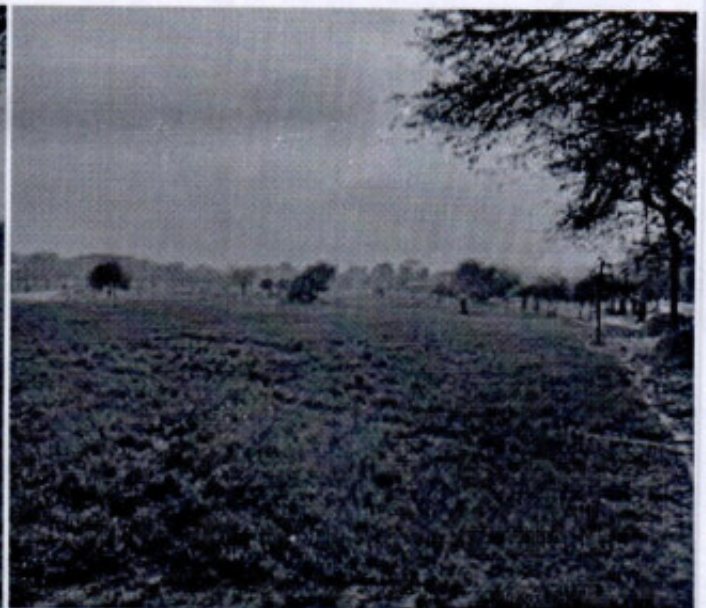

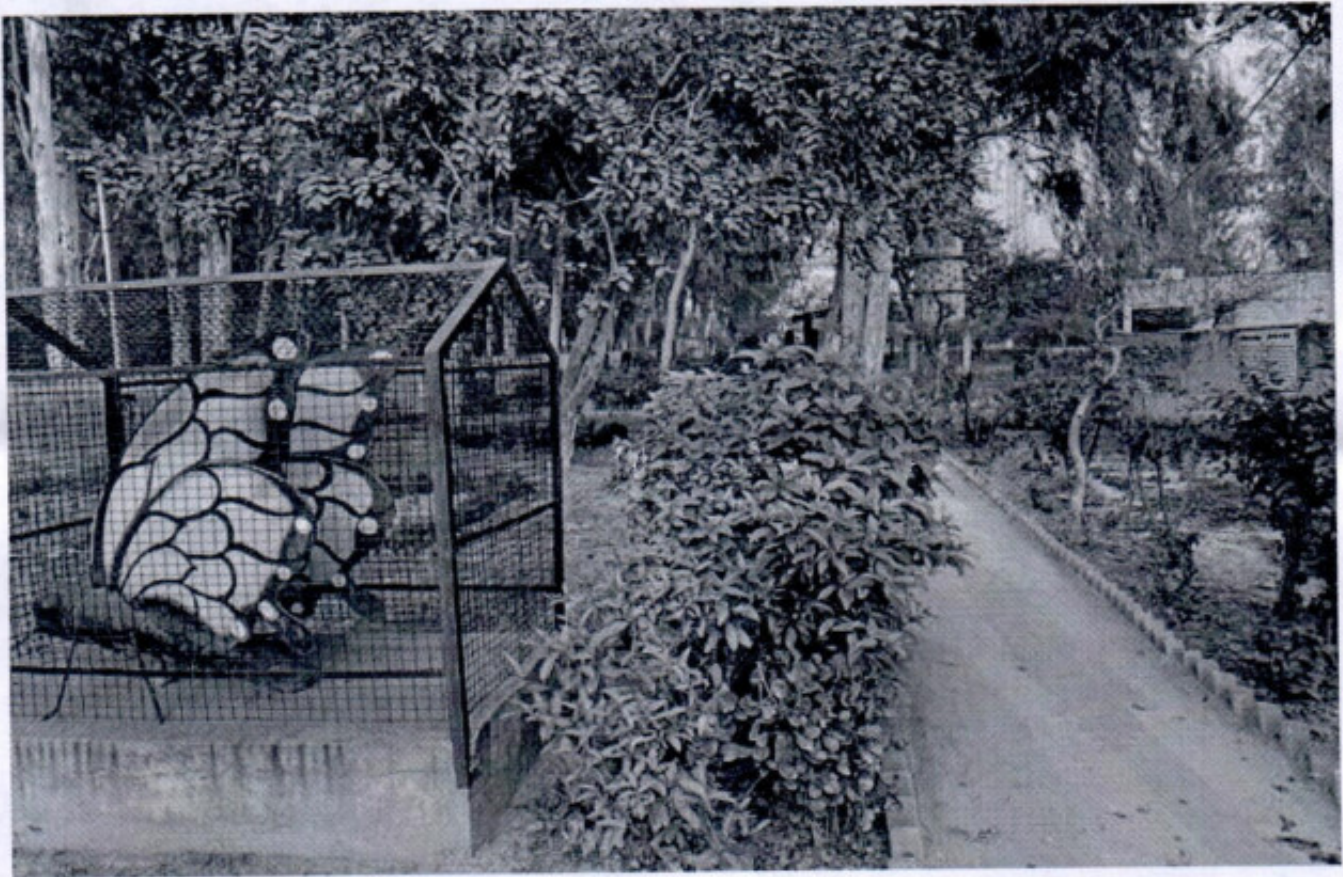


