The Anagodu Forest Block is situated on either sides of the National Highway No. 4 on Davanagere to Bangalore road, spread over 151.56 ha. It is about 18 Kms. from Davanagere. The Southern forest block of 101 ha. houses "Indira Priyadarshini Prani Sangrahalaya".
