2 History Of the zoo

The Children's Park cum Mini Zoo is situated in Kalaburagi town and located within the Municipal garden. It was established in 1988 and extends over an area of 6.33 ac. The Children Park cum Mini Zoo was initially granted recognition in 1997 by the Central Zoo Authority and extended subsequently. In April 2015 the Central Zoo Authority has granted recognition to the zoo under Section 38H of the Wildlife (Protection)Act, for the period upto 30.04.2017.

Children's Park cum Mini Zoo came into existence in 1988 in Sy. No.2 of Brahmapur Block IV within the Kalaburagi Municipal Garden limits and belongs to the City Corporation. It extends over an area of 6.33.

It lies between the longitudinal parallels of 76 04' and 77 42' east of Greenwich and latitudinal parallels of 16 12' and 17 46' north of Equator.

The Zoo boundary description is as follows:

North: Park road

South : Hotel Mayura (KSTDC Hotel)

East : City corporation Park

West : School run by Rotary Club.

5 Objectives






