Report of the officer-in- charge

As the head of a prestigious and famed Kittur Rani Channamma Nisarg Dham, Bhutaramanahatti also known as Belagavi Zoo located in the North Karnataka district of Belagavi; the birth land of great ruler of Kittur Rani Channamma; it gives sense of extreme pride and gratitude to shed light on the developmental activities and conservational education programme undertaken at our zoo through Annual Report of zoo for the year 2023-24. Recently the Kittur Rani Channamma Nisarg Dham, Bhutaramanahatti zoo has become a very important Tourism and recreational place with regards continuing development works in the year 2023-24 as well which are been taken up by Zak as per Master(Layout) approved by CZA.

The Kittur Rani Channamma Nisarg Dham, Bhutaramanahatti zoo although has been lacking in adequate funding to carryout different developmental works as per Master(Layout) as previously. The situation is improving with the present authorities recognizing the potential of our zoo which has led to generous allocation of funds for developmental activities during the year 2023-24. The ticket revenue further has compensated the dearth developmental funds making the zoo financially viable leading the zoo to reach near breakeven point during the year 2023-24.

One very important event that is exchange of THREE EMUs to Chitradurga Zoo has skyrocketed the name of the zoo on the map of animal exchange which enhances the credibility of with regards to conservation and breeding of important species in the future to come. This further strengthens the scientific and conservational plan of the zoo towards acquisition and management of different key species at this very zoo.

Creation of awareness in masses through social media, public awareness, celebrated of important days, wildlife week by participation of children, youth, environmentalist, govt. officials, bureaucrates and zoo visitors has been taken up on regular basis during the year 2023-24. A wide publicity concentrating on animal adoption programmes is being carried out regularly and the efficiency has shown increasing trend.

History of the Zoo

The Mini Zoo was established on 02-10-1989 at Bhutharamanahatti village in Kakati Range of Belagavi Forest Division and Situated at a distance of 12 Km from Belagavi City. Initially 12 No,s of deers and 3 nilgai were placed in separate enclosures. Later on keeping in mind the importance and the potential of the area, an extent of 31.68 Ha area was carved out from Bhutramnahatti & Honaga Reserve Forests and fenced. Later on it was named as Kittur Rani Channamma Mini Zoo .

It is located on the Banglore-Pune highway, near Belagavi city with a number of Educational Institutions and surrounded by industries. With these attributes, it does attract a large number of children and tourists at present. With improvements and expansion proposed, it would be a centre for not only recreation and entertainment but also scientific management of wild animals and conservation education.




