

- Instinct and behaviour while in captivity.
- Provide space to individual animals as per CZA guidelines and maintain their natural back into the wild due to various reasons.
- Take care of permanent residents who require life time care and who cannot be released back into the natural habitat.
- Provide shelter and treatment to the injured leopards and deliver best medication for the leopards which can then be released back into the natural habitat.
- To rescue leopard from distressful situation and where possible rehabilitate them back into the wild.

Manikdoh Leopard Rescue Centre objectives are:

5. Objective

The Mission of Manikdoh Leopard Rescue Centre is to establish protocol to reduce man-leopard conflict around conflicted nearby areas and ensure timely veterinary assistance for the leopards and would be involved in rescuing leopards from distressful situations with collaborative support of the MFD.

4. Mission

The prime vision of the rescue centre was to house these rescued leopards who were in considerable distress in trap cages/transit cages for long periods. Some of these leopards, only required medical aid and were consequently medicated and then released back in the wild.


