2. History of the Zoo:-

Rewalsar Mini Zoo spreading over an area of 4 hac, is one of the centre of attraction for visitors and Nature lovers in Rewalsar. Established in April 1983, it served as main rescue centre for injured or accidently caught animals from surrounding areas. The Mini Zoo is recognized by Central Zoo Authority, MoEF & CC, Govt. of India. At present, this Zoo harbors and displays species like Barking Deer, Sambar, Goral, Spotted deer, Himalayan Black Bear, Porcupine.

3. Vision:

The zoo will have healthy animals in naturalistic enclosures in presence of Competent staff to handle them and also with good educational and interpretative facilities.

4. Mission:

To offer excellent public service, recreation, and to provide eco-awareness to public. To encourage the people to develop a caring attitude towards wild animals.

- 5. Objective:
- (1) To create awareness about Nature and Wild Life Conservation, recreation and knowledge of Wild Life through study of animal behavior.
- (2) To exhibit the Wild animals in an environment as close as possible to their natural one with opportunity to the visitors also to watch them in similar natural conditions.
- (3) The main objective is to conserve wild animals and to impart conservation education and awareness about the wild animals of the region.
- (4) To exhibit the Wild animals in such a way so as to provide them an environment as close as possible to their natural one and extending an opportunity to the visitors also to watch them in similar natural conditions.
- (5) To provide required recreation and entertainment facilities to the visitors.
- (6) To provide opportunities of research to students on the animal ecology, behavior and disease etc.




i. Replacement of old/damaged interlink chain in sambar enclosure.




ii. Construction Interlink Chain Around Post Mortom Room.






iv. C/O Drain In Present Sambar(Female) Enclosure.




