#### 1. MANIPUR ZOOLOGICAL GARDEN

#### 1.1 About Manipur Zoological Garden:

Manipur Zoological Garden was established on 2<sup>nd</sup> October, 1976 on the advice of the then State Wildlife Advisory Board. It covers an area of 8.17 Ha at Iroisemba, Imphal which is about 8kms from Imphal city. Manipur Zoo is home to a number of rare and endangered species which are endemic to this region, many of which are included in Schedule I and Schedule II of the Wildlife (Protection) Act, 1972. Manipur Zoological Garden was categorised as a "Medium Zoo" by the Central Zoo Authority (CZA) on 02.02.2009. It was further identified to be developed as a "model zoo" by CZA in November, 2014.

Manipur Zoological Garden maintained a Captive Breeding Centre (CBC) at the Langol Reserve Forest which extends to an area of 6.007 ha. for three (3) important species; (i) Browantlered deer (The State Animal of Manipur), (ii) Mrs Hume's Bar Pheasant (The State Bird of Manipur and (iii) Kalij Pheasant.

#### 1.2 Objectives:

- i. Conservation of Wildlife sustain population of physically, genetically and behaviourally healthy animals.
- ii. Captive breeding –eg. Sangai, Kalij pheasant.
- iii. Ex-situ conservation of endangered species appropriate to provide stock for recovery programme.
- iv. Resource of natural gene pool.
- v. Source of scientific data behaviour, nutrition, pathology, breeding.
- vi. Education and awareness.
- vii. Recreation.

# 2. ACTIVITIES OF MANIPUR ZOOLOGICAL GARDEN FOR PERIOD APRIL, 2016 TO MARCH, 2017.

#### 2.1 Animal Enclosures and Upkeep:

The following activities were taken up as a part of improving upon the existing enclosures, and enhancing the enrichment activities to improve the condition of animal enclosures:

- a) Daily cleaning is done for all the enclosures before feeding by the respective zoo keepers/ animal attendants.
- b) Sweeping and cleaning the visitor areas are done by a group of sweepers.
- c) Weekly cleaning of the Zoo Campus is done every Monday which is a holiday for the Zoo and closed to the visitor.
- d) The veterinary doctor also takes important role in maintaining sanitation of the zoo particularly for the enclosures and the waste disposal sites. He is the custodian of all cleaning chemicals.
- e) The team take care of the proper functioning of drainage system of the campus, cleanliness of the animal enclosures/cages and houses, maintain the lawns, the visitor amenities and general cleanliness of the zoo campus.

The routine work for upkeep of Zoo including Maintenance of enclosures, visitor amenities, infra-structures including boundary wall, office buildings, veterinary set up, visitor roads, external approach road to zoo, museum, ticket counter, staff quarter, drainage, water supply, electric and other facilities are done by a team consisting of 2 Range Officers as assisted by Deputy Rangers Foresters and Forest Guards under the overall supervision of the Director as per the recommendation.

The following construction of new enclosures was done during the year 2016-17:

- i. Construction of SAMBHAR ENCLOSURE WITH NIGHT SHELTER at MZG
- ii. Construction of DEER ENCLOSURE WITH NIGHT SHELTER at MZG
- iii. Extension of KALIJ PHEASANT ENCLOSURE at Captive Breeding Centre (CBC)
- iv. Construction of pucca boundary wall between North-eastern side of CBC.
- v. Construction of boundary brick wall adjacent to CAU southern side Phase I of MZG
- vi. Construction of boundary brick wall adjacent to CAU southern side Phase II of MZG
- vii. Construction of one night shelter & improvement of Hoolock Gibbon enclosure at MZG

#### 2.2 Animal Health care:

Veterinary section is headed by a Veterinary Officer assisted by Animal Attendants. At present, the zoo has no Veterinary Field Assistant for assisting the Veterinary officer. Facilities for drugs, medicines, the feed supplements and sanitation are available for the animals.

Animal Health care activities are as follows:

- a. Precaution and preventive measures against any outbreak of disease is maintained by regular spraying of Kohrsolin solution and lime-bleach around all the animal enclosures throughout the year.
- b. Daily supply of Supplements such as Mineral mixture, Calcium, B-Complex, etc. are given to the Zoo inmates.
- c. De-worming of Zoo inmates is done every 3-month.
- d. The Veterinary officer and its team regularly kept check of the injuries and illness of the Zoo inmates.
- e. Vaccination programme for cattles around the Zoo areas is done on regular basis against Food and Mouth diseases.
- f. Facility of referring sick animal to the State Veterinary Hospital which is only 8 kms away from the Zoo is done as and when required.

#### 2.4 Other activities:

#### 2.4.1 Observance of Swachh Bharat Mission

Swachh Bharat Mission was observed for the period of 1<sup>st</sup> to 15<sup>th</sup> June, 2016 as a part of the Action Plan on Swachh Bharat Mission to maintain hygiene and cleanliness in the surrounding areas of Zoo. Shops around the Zoo campus were made to mandatorily place a dust-bin while the Zoo and its surrounding areas were made a "plastic free" zone.



### 2.4.2 World Environment Day Celebrated on 5th June, 2016

World Environment Day was observed on 5<sup>th</sup> June, 2016 with an awareness programme of locals and visitors. This not only maintain the cleanliness and sanctity of the Zoo and its surrounding areas but also helped instilling in the Zoo staffs, visitors and the locals, a habit of keeping their surrounding neat and clean.



#### 2.4.3 Cleanliness Drive

Social service on mass scale was carried out every Monday (non-visitors' day), in addition to the routine daily cleaning activities of the Zoo. The main focus was given to the water points and toilets within the Zoo premises.



#### 2.4.4 Sensitization on cleanliness by Veterinary Officer

A temporary sensitization area was set up where students, visitors and locals were educated and made aware of the importance of cleanliness and hygiene especially in the natural areas.



## 2.4.5 Zoo Foundation Day Celebrated on $2^{nd}$ October, 2016

The 40<sup>th</sup> Zoo Foundation day was celebrated on 2<sup>nd</sup> October, 2016 which kick start the week long Wildlife Week Celebration, 2016. The Brochure on Manipur Zoological Garden was also released on this day by the PCCF/Wildlife, Forest Department, Government of Manipur.


