These include Black Bluck, Sambar, Chittal and Chinkara They are Breeding regularly. There is a designated area for visitiors & view the animals. Entery is Free for visitors. Zoo Providing free Parking Facility.The animals are look after will very well. One veterinary from veterinary Hospital visits when required. There is need to have water supply system from Public health department & electricity from electricity department.

2. History of the Zoo

Deer Park Hisar is situated on Hisar – Dhansu Road at Hisar. It was started in 1970-71,with in a patch of 27acres of natural mixed forest . Now the area of the Deer Park Hisar is 48 acre including 6 acres fodder plot .

Deer Park Hisar is 6km. away form Bus stand Hisar and 8km. from Railway station Hisar. The Deer Park is well connected to Delhi, Chandigarh, Jaipur and other important cites by road. There is a good network of approachable roads from all sides of the Deer Park. Delhi is the nearest Airport which is 170km.

To impart conservation message to the visitors.

To develop amongst visitors an empathy for wild animals and motivate them to support the cause of conservation

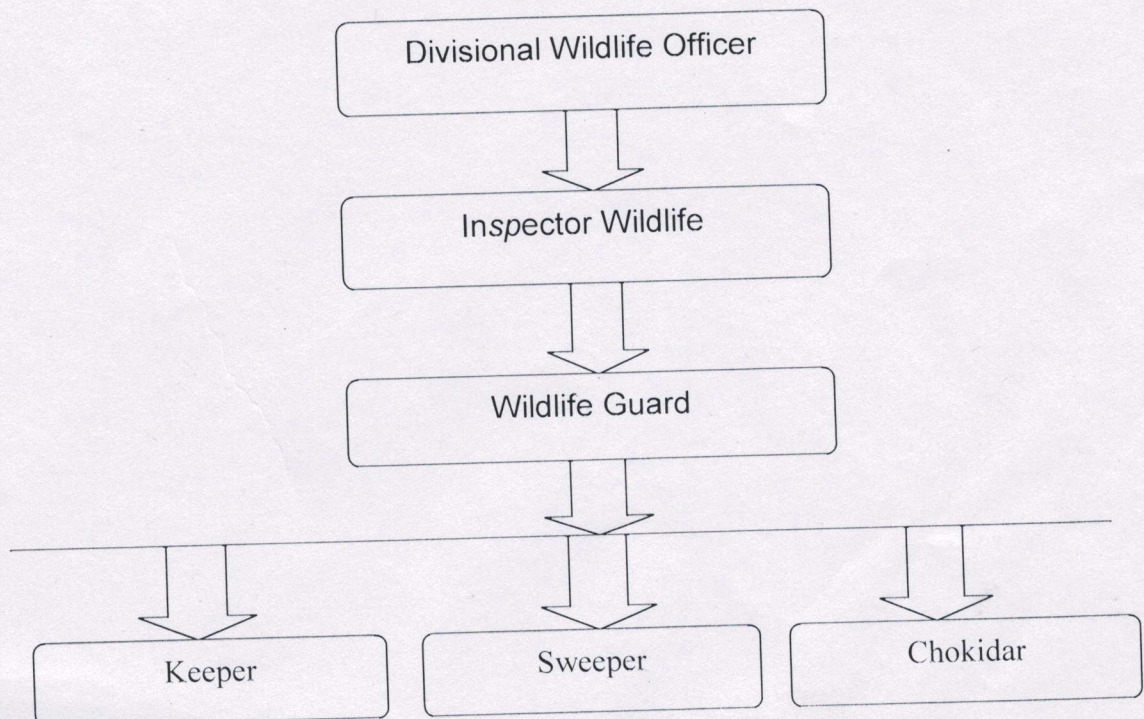




