1. Report of the Officer-in-charge

The Kittur Rani Chennamma Mini Zoo, Bhutharamanahatti is situated 12 km from Belgavi (Belgaum) on the Bangalore-Belgavi- Poona highway. Belgavi, also known as Belgaum till recently is a City Corporation in Belgavi district in the State of Karnataka. The city is nearly 762m above sea level and is the Head Quarters for the Belgavi district. The States of Maharashtra and Goa borders the district. Belgavi is one of the oldest, strong, prominent and well cultured historical place nestling high in the Western Ghats. The old town area with cotton and silk weavers stands gloriously besides the modern, bustling, tree lined British Cantonment. Step out of the forts and you have a wide choice of temples and churches to visit. Belgavi has an enviable heritage and offers much to be discovered. It lies in the zone of cultural transition between Karnataka, Maharashtra and Goa with a known antiquity clearly traceable up to 2nd century AD. Due to its proximity with these two States, Belgavi has acquired the cultural flavor of these States and blended it with the local kannada culture to create a rich heritage, which is unique in its manifestation. Belgavi has now become one of the important and considered districts in the State of Karnataka.

In 2006, the Government of Karnataka announced that Belgavi would be made the State's second capital and the city would be a permanent venue for the annual fifteen day session of the State Legislature. A second State administrative building 'Suvarna Vidhana Soudha' was inaugurated in Belgavi on 11th October, 2012 and sessions of the State Legislature are since being held here.

The Kittur Rani Chennamma Mini Zoo were established in 1989 at Bhutramanahatti in Kakti Forest Range of Belgavi Forest Division. The Zoo is rightly named in the memory of the brave Queen Rani Chennaimma of the then princely State of Kittur in Belgavi district. She

led an armed rebellion against the British in 1824, which ended in her martyrdom. She was one of the earliest Indians and the first Indian Queen to have fought for our Independence.

The mini zoo was established in 1989 and covers an area of 31.68 ha and is surrounded by nearly 1000 ha of Reserve Forest of Bhutramanahatti, Honaga, Halabhavi, Heggeri, and Ukkad villages. It is very strategically located on the Bangalore-Pune highway, near Belagavi city with a number of Educational Institutions and surrounded by Industries. With these attributes, it does attract a large number of children and tourists at present. With improvements and expansion proposed, it would be a centre for not only entertainment and recreation but also scientific management of wild animals and conservation education.

2. History of the Zoo

The mini zoo was established in 1989 and covers an area of 34.48 Ha and is surrounded by nearly 1000 Ha of reserve Forest of Bhutharamanahatti, Honaga, Halabhavi, Heggeri, and Ukkad villages. It is very strategically located on the Bangalore-Pune highway, near Belagavi city with a number of Educational Institutions and surrounded by industries. With these attributes, it does attract a large number of children and tourists at present. With improvements and expansion proposed, it would be a centre for not only recreation and entertainment but also scientific management of wild animals and conservation education.




