1. Mission Statement of Zoo:

This mission will be accomplished through housing healthy wild animals in aesthetically designed naturalistic and spacious enclosures with good health care facility and to achieve the distinction of being recognized as a unique and beautiful Zoo making the visitors leaves with a satisfying and happy note.

Executive Directors Report

I had taken over as Executive Director of Children's Park Cum Mini Zoo, Binkadakatti, Gadag as it is attached to the office of Deputy Conservator of Forests, Gadag Division, Gadag on 26-03-2015. Since I had background of Forestry and special Interest in wildlife, I was confident of discharging the duties ably as the Executive Director of Binkadakatti Zoo.

My immediate task after taking charge of the zoo was to further enhance the reputation of the Binkadakatti Zoo, which is the only zoo in North Karnataka having good number of animal species, ensuring greenery and cleanliness, management of captive wild animals in accordance with the principals of modern zoo management, zoo education, facilitating visitors, creating awareness towards ex-situ conservation among masses, media etc. The other priorities were to provide enrichment, health care & staff welfare etc. it was also required to take up essential development works for better upkeep of animals, while being cautious and judicious in spending the hard earned money of zoo.

Awareness generation is the main activity carried out by this zoo that too particularly among children of age group 10-20years with this point of view. 2016-17 year was very memorable in the history of Binkadakatti zoo, as we celebrated 2nd time wildlife week in the month of October by involving school children, college students, environmentalists, officials and local people. We organized different events and competitions for students in zoo premises. Though out the week local MLAs and MP participated in the program with enthusiasm, wide publicity was given to zoo, concentrating especially animal adoption program. In the year 2016-17 we have undertaken many development projects in the zoo promises, construction of separate veg & non-veg kitchen as well as office of the Range officer zoo was

completed during the period. The existing aviary was renovated as walk through aviary and children's play equipments were upgraded.

As per the Guidelines of Central Zoo Authority, for the first time we have prepared Master (layout) plan for the period of ten years from 2014-15 to 2024-25. Getting approval for Master Plan; will allow the zoo to have many ambitious projects. Among them, the construction of new enclosures for Lion, Hyena, Primates, Snake Park, Butterfly Park, Construction of Multimedia theatre and Auditorium are a few worth mentioning. Though Binkadakatti zoo team has given its 100% efforts to bring this zoo at the level on par with the best zoos known in Karnataka, still lot more works are to be done. Many more enclosure, better up keep and greater facilities are the deciding factors for better future of Binkadakatti zoo. This zoo fulfills many criteria to be declared as small zoo. Declaration to small zoo will allow Binkadakatti zoo to house variety of animals which will enhance the popularity of the zoo and this zoo will serve the purpose of ex-situ conservation.

I extend my heartfelt thanks to one and all for extending their cooperation including the Chairman, Member Secretary and Governing Council members of Zoo Authority of Karnataka and also the Central Zoo Authority, forest Department, Local administration media and general public for smooth functioning of the zoo.

3. Objectives:

- 1. Improve the animal health, conservation and maintenance facilities and provide new exhibits
- 2. Provide on-site staff work space that enhances efficiency, productivity and collaboration
- 3. Enhance the zoo's financial stability by creating facilities and programs that yield new, year round revenue streams
- 4. Improve visitors experience, through recreation which shall be incidental and not the basic objective
- 5. Promoting conservation education programs
- 6. Participating in conservation breeding programs
- 7. Helping in Rescue & Rehabilitation of the wild animals
- 8. Facilitating Research and documentation activities

4. Strategies for achieving objectives:

- 1. Develop state of art veterinary care and sanitation facilities for the housed exhibits and planning for new animal collection. To inspire amongst zoo visitors empathy for wild animals through schemes of adoption, donations etc
- 2. Human Resource Development of Zoo through suitable trainings and excursions arranged for dedicated staff for a better output in zoo management
- 3. Providing state of art infrastructure and appropriate amenities for visitors like; information counter and interpretation hall, better roads, improved walk paths, aesthetically designed parks, Pergolas, canteen facilities, new enclosures, water supply, Power supply back up, security, waste and sewage disposal etc which increases the visitor inflow

- 4. Making Binkadakatti Zoo, Gadag a place for public learning about wild animals, plants and ecosystem through interaction with and immersion in the original or simulated natural habitats of sights, sound and smell
- 5. Initiating Zoo education program for teachers and students and involving school and college children for creating awareness among general public and developing a state of art Interpretation center. Also celebrating wildlife week and World environment day with a message of conservation
- 6. Supporting conservation of endangered species through coordinated breeding and rehabilitation program as directed by CZA & ZAK with active collaboration with WII, ZSI, universities, national and International zoos.

Providing opportunities for scientific studies-sharing the knowledge between the agencies involved in ex- situ conservation

5. Establishment

Binkadakatti Zoo is housing more than 170 animals comprising of 24 species, with nearly 1.0 lakhs visitors. The zoo has achieved success in scientific display of animals on modern lines, as per the guidelines of Central Zoo Authority. The around achievement of zoo is due to the total dedication of the staff and their commitment in upkeep of animals, enrichment, education, creating infrastructure and cleanliness which is major factor for efficient management of the zoo, it is also necessary to induce discipline, punctuality, proper duties and responsibilities to zoo staff.

Binkadakatti Zoo is experiencing shortage of man power, for the reason that there is no recruitment from long time. Though the zoo is managing with the assistance of persons working on contract basis.






