

Annual Report on Panchwati Deer Park, Pilani

1- Introduction:-

Panchwati Deer Park was established on 14th February, 1967. It is situated at main road near Talab in Pilani, District Jhunjhunu (Rajasthan) .

It was a sacred dream of Syt. L. N. Birla who wanted to create in Pilani a cultural environment and legacy for generations to come. The tableaux all including water fall, hillock, tunnel pass, rock model, huts, animal activities are available for public and tourists.

The Total Area of Zoo is 10 hectares (5.5 hectares only as Deer Park). The theme of ancient epic – Ramayan – i.e. Lord Rams' visit to van (forest) adds to the knowledge of both young and old by the tableaux present there which cover an area of 4.5 hectares.

The Deer Park has animals- Samber deers (Rusa unicolor). The suitable season for visiting this Deer Park is February – March and October-November. There is normal rainfall in this area in rainy season. For visiting the zoo, the routes ex Delhi, Jaipur, Bikaner, Hissar to Pilani are available by direct buses all the 24 hrs. The facilities of pleasant stay are readily available in various guest houses nearby.

Even foreign visitors are also seen devoting considerable time in Sight-Seeing apart from noting down and enjoying. Our main aim of educating people, relaxing, mental peace for all round happiness is almost fulfilled.
