1. **Report of the Officer-in-charge** :- Year 2022-23 presented many challenges and constraints regarding management of Patiala Zoo, but we managed to deal with this situation and saw many positive advancements during the financial year 2022-23. The recognition of Patiala Zoo as a small category zoo is renewed upto 19/08/2022. In order to extend its recognition further, a Fees of 1,00000/- was deposited in the account of CZA vide Receipt No.3053 dated. 7/06/2023 and a request was also made to CZA in this regard vide letter No.745 dated. 29/05/2023. The Master Layout Plan of Zoo was also approved by Central Zoo Authority (Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change, Govt. of India.) During the Year 2022-23, following works were undertaken.

1. One visitor shed was constructed inside the Patiala Zoo the Convenience of visitors from scorching heat of sun and rains.
2. Parking area for vehicles was suitably modified to accommodate the increasing numbers of Two and three wheelers.
3. An isolation chamber was formed for Hog deer.
4. Visitors path was modified near the monkey enclosure.
5. Interpretation Centre was white washed and painted.

I hope, in coming years the Patiala Zoo would become a major tourist spot for the public and wildlife lovers.

2. **History of the Zoo** :- Patiala Zoo, Patiala previously known by the name Moti Bagh Deer Park was established in 1968 within the Bir Moti Bagh Wild Life Sanctuary. It was initially given the status of a Deer Park. It has now been recognized as a Small Zoo by Central Zoo Authority, Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change, Govt. of India. It is the first deer park in the state of Punjab which was established and managed by the department of Forests and Wildlife Preservation.
3. **Vision**:- To enable Patiala Zoo become the best in its category by becoming a conducive ground for ex-situ conservation of local and exotic fauna as well as spreading awareness about wildlife among people of Punjab.
4. **Mission**:- Patiala Zoo will have healthy animals which will be kept in near natural environment suiting their biological and social needs and displaying them for educational and interpretive purposes to generate public support and to promote eco tourism with an equal emphasis on in-situ conservation and making the zoo self sufficient in achieving its goals and objectives."

This master plan is devoted to ways and means of meeting the goal and realizing the strategic vision for 2039. This document is a blue print for 20 years of zoo development perspective and provides a broad framework for future programme. The document embodies vision in all dimensions of zoo development focusing on wildlife collection, resource inventory, captive management and development, institutional strengthening and capacity building, education, research, extension and human resource development.

The master plan has defined the purpose of Patiala Zoo in clear and concise terms with intended concepts and has set out the basic guidelines which are to be adopted. It has also looked into layout including existing components like animal enclosures, visitor amenities, and veterinary facilities, other facilities like entrance, parking, educational facilities, research facilities, landscape and gardening as well as in-situ conservation areas as per plan for its development.

5. Objectives:-

1. To educate the people regarding wildlife, their habitat, food habits and status etc.
2. Ex-situ maintenance and conservation of endangered species in captivity.
3. To enhance knowledge of animal behavior by conducting research and study on management of wildlife in captivity.

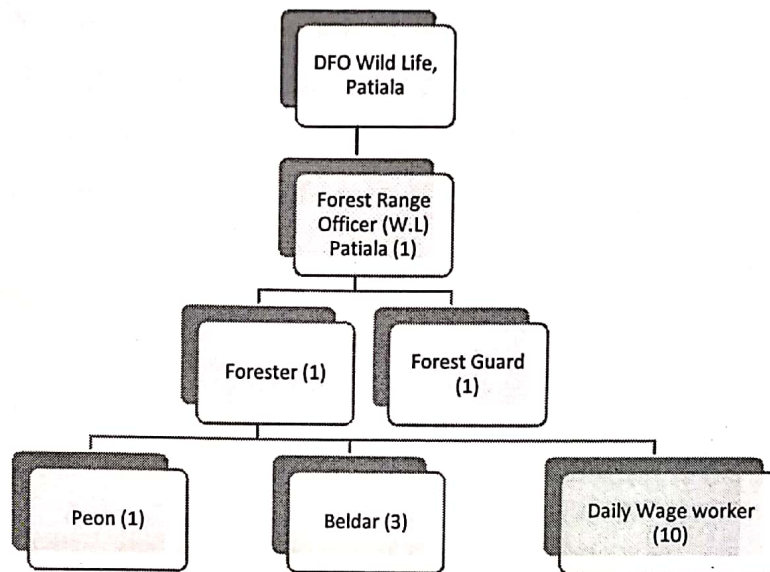



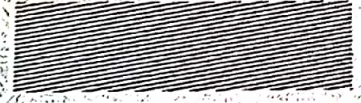
