<b>Visitor Facilities</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• There are two big umbrellas and quite a good number of concrete benches for the visitors to take rest</li> <li>• Urinals / toilets are also there to use for the visitors separately for gents and ladies.</li> <li>• For the amusement of children, construction of a small children park with swings, slopes etc. is felt absolutely necessary. In this context, there is a provision for creation of a Central Park with Day Visitor Centre/ Food Court in the approved Master Lay-out Plan.</li> <li>• Drinking water supply facility and road network within the zoo are available, but it needs to be improved.</li> <li>• As per approved Master Layout Plan, proposed landscaping and beautification work with a Central Park &amp; Food Court will be done. Proposal with estimate for the first phase work of beautification and landscaping has been sent to WBZA for release of fund. For creation of Central Park, Prakalpa Architecture Firm, Kolkata (deputed by WBZA) visited and surveyed the area by this time on the basis of which they will submit a project to WBZA for implementation.</li> <li>• Visitors' amenities to be enhanced and of course new road network is needed for new enclosures in future which is in the master lay out plan and being undertaken. Visitors' circulation is also under development programme.</li> <li>• A watch tower with 65' height at the northern side of the zoo is built to have a bird's eye view of the surrounding forest patch with the captive and free living animal species as well as the adjacent urban localities to the visitors (now not in operation).</li> </ul>
