With reference to above, I am directed to inform that the recognition of Gadag Zoo (Children's park cum Zoo, Binkadakatti, Gadag), Karnataka was accorded up to August 19th, 2021 vide reference no. 3 above. The application for the renewal of recognition of Gadag Zoo (Children's park cum Zoo, Binkadakatti, Gadag), Karnataka for the period beyond August 19th, 2021 was received by this office vide reference no. 2 above.

Shri Surendra Kumar, IFS(Retd.), Former PCCF(CWLW), Kerala was deputed by this office to carry out the evaluation of the Gadag Zoo (Children's park cum Zoo, Binkadakatti, Gadag), Karnataka vide CZA letter at reference no. 1 above. The Zoo was accordingly evaluated on March 29th, 2022.

The evaluation report (copy enclosed) as submitted by the evaluation officer was deliberated in the 106th meeting of the Technical Committee of the Central Zoo Authority held on September 27th, 2022. The Technical Committee after detailed deliberations recommended to the Central Zoo Authority for the renewal of recognition of Gadag Zoo (Children's park cum Zoo, Binkadakatti, Gadag), Karnataka for a period of two years and to regularise the period after August 19th, 2021, subject to compliance with observation/recommendation in the table below and mid-term evaluation. The members also recommended that the Zoo Operator may be directed to submit half-yearly compliance report with respect to observation/recommendation stipulated while renewal of recognition.
