With reference to above, I am directed to inform that the recognition of G.B. Pant High Altitude Zoo, Nainital, Uttarakhand was accorded up to August 19<sup>th</sup>, 2021 vide reference no. 3 above. The application for the renewal of recognition of G.B. Pant High Altitude Zoo, Nainital, Uttarakhand for the period beyond August 19<sup>th</sup>, 2021 was received by this office vide reference no. 2 above.
