Sir,

With reference to above, I am directed to inform that the recognition of Renuka Ji Mini Zoo, Himachal Pradesh was accorded up to August 19<sup>th</sup>, 2021 vide reference no. 3 above. The application for the renewal of recognition of Renuka Ji Mini Zoo, Himachal Pradesh for the period beyond August 19<sup>th</sup>, 2021 was received by this office vide reference no. 2 above.

Shri Rahul Bhatnagar, IFS(Retd.), Former CCF Udaipur, Rajasthan was deputed by this office to carry out the evaluation of the Renuka Ji Mini Zoo, Himachal Pradesh vide CZA letter at reference no. 1 above. The Zoo was accordingly evaluated on June 9<sup>th</sup>, 2022.

The evaluation report (copy enclosed) as submitted by the evaluation officer was deliberated in the 106<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Technical Committee of the Central Zoo Authority held on September 27<sup>th</sup>, 2022. The Technical Committee after detailed deliberations recommended to the Central Zoo Authority for the renewal of recognition of Renuka Ji Mini Zoo, Himachal Pradesh for a period of two years and to regularise the period after August 19<sup>th</sup>, 2021, subject to compliance with observation/ recommendation in the table below and mid-term evaluation. The members also recommended that the Zoo Operator may be directed to submit half-yearly compliance report with respect to observation/ recommendation stipulated while renewal of recognition.

Subsequently, the recommendation of 106<sup>th</sup> Technical Committee Meeting was approved by the Chairperson, Central Zoo Authority. 
